The Department has received the Title V General Permit Notification Form for the dry cleaning facility that you submitted on April 11, 2007.



Dear Mr. Michael Galyean,

It was a pleasure to speak with you today regarding the refunds which will be forthcoming due to overpayment (\$50.00 each facility) of your annual emission fees for the above referenced facilities, the Air General Permit for Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaners (entitlement to operate), the renewal process upon entitlement expiration, and issues surrounding changes in ownership.

As we discussed the Air General permit is **not transferable upon a change of ownership**. As the result, a new registration form should have been submitted by you thirty (30) days in advance of your closing on the **2881 Clark Road** facility. It is customary that the previous owner notify us by letter when a change of ownership is imminent, and at the same time it is his/her responsibility to inform the new owner of his/her requirement to submit a new registration form prior to the sale. This process accommodates a seamless transition with respect to the permitting (entitlement to operate) process from the current owner to the new owner.

Also during our conversation, I mentioned that the permit for the **3509 Manatee Ave** facility expired on **September 1, 2006**. Air General Permits are valid for a period of five (5) years and your last registration was submitted on August 01, 2001 and effective September 01, 2001.

If you are the **Responsible Official**, please complete the form, print your name, sign your name and date the last page of the form. The form itself begins on page 14 and ends on page 17. Pages 1-13 provide an overview of the rule, and pages 18 thru 19 provide directions for completing the form.
