
This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on March 26, 2008. We have assigned ARMS No. 0810216-002 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.



- 2) when the cement is blended with water, sand and gravel if necessary.

### **Description of Facility**

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used.

The cement trucks enter the premise on a paved drive. They drive to the cement silo on unpaved ground. Emissions from this area are controlled by wetting, if necessary. Cement from the silo is blended with water, sand and filler in the correct proportions to make wet cement. The wet cement is poured into forms to make precast concrete items. Fugitive emissions are controlled using a water hose if necessary.

The existing permitted cement storage silo controls emissions created during loading using a WAM Silotop R01 baghouse having a total cloth filtration area of 264 ft<sup>2</sup> with a design flow rate of 1500 acfm. The facility receives approximately 27 tons cement per refill.

A second cement silo and an ash silo will be added to the site to give three silos total. The new one will be a dual silo able to contain both cement and ash. Each compartment of this silo will have its own baghouse to control emissions. Later an ash silo will be added and the dual silo will be used for cement only. It will have its own baghouse to control emissions. Each of the baghouses will be like that on the existing silo. The emissions from each will be controlled by a WAM Silotop R01 baghouse having a total cloth filtration area of 264 ft<sup>2</sup> with a design flow rate of 1500 acfm.



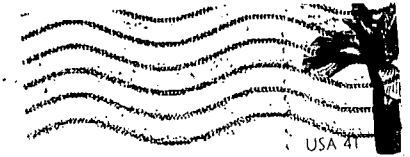

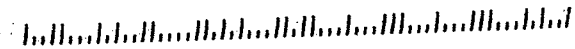
