Dear Mr. Fernandez:

This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on October 15, 2007. We have assigned ARMS Number 0910091-003 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.

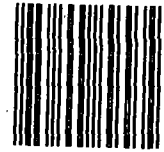
Kindred Hearts is an existing facility conducting pet cremation services. Kindred Hearts operates under DEP ARMS number 0910091-002-AG. We use an animal crematory unit capable of less than 500 pounds per hour. Compliance demonstration testing for carbon monoxide and particulate matter emissions standards was previously submitted and is on file with the Department of Environmental Protection. Our Facility Regulatory Classification is as a minor source of Pollutants.

We again request the maximum operating schedule of 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 52 weeks a year or 8,760 hours annually. Based on the maximum permitted operation time of 8,760 hours per year, particulate matter (PM), carbon monoxide (CO), Nitrogen oxides (NOx), sulfur dioxide (SO2) and volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions are expected to be less than 5 tons per year. The actual expected usage of this unit is less than 2500 hours per year.

Our cremation of animal remains is conducted through a dual chamber natural gas fired cremation unit (Industrial Equipment and Engineering Company, Model Power-Pac II). There have been no modifications to the equipment. The secondary chamber operating temperature is 1600 degrees Fahrenheit or higher at the initiation of cremation and throughout the combustion process. Temperature monitoring equipment is used and documentation available for inspection. The unit's pollution control, opacity monitoring of stack emissions, is engaged and monitored when the unit is in operation. Additionally, visual checks of the stack are made throughout the cremation process.

Our annual visible emissions testing is conducted through Pensacola P.O.C., with reports being submitted to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Northwest District. Our facility has demonstrated compliance with the visible emissions (VE) standards.

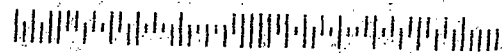
