#### **Description of Facility**

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used.

The plant is currently using 4 concrete mixer trucks for loading and delivery. Ready Mix production is approximately 0 to 300 cubic yards of concrete a day when the facility is in operation. Currently the facility is in operation on an intermittent amount of days during the week, and can be closed for business on any given day. If production of Ready Mix Concrete is increased and economic conditions improve, the facility may be open, Monday-Saturday, 6 days a week. Hours of operation can be between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Products being used are Portland Cement, Fly Ash and natural aggregates.

The concrete batch plant runs on a closed loop system, and all equipment and processes are current and will be kept in compliance. Daily inspections of the facility are conducted and documented.

A 2 compartment cement silo and fly ash silo, split at 60% cement capacity and 40% Fly Ash capacity is modern and maintained on a daily basis. The silos hold cement and fly ash, and have a capacity of 837 barrels. There are 2 Stephens models SV-170 and SV-265 silo dust collection bag houses mounted on top of the cement and fly ash silos. One unit contains 25-8" x 39" filter bags and the other consists of 16-8" x 39" filter bags, and is equipped with a high volume, high pressure reverse pulse jet cleaning mechanism. The cement batcher is enclosed by a C&W CP-35 Enclosed Dust Collection system. Each side of the silo pipes, have anti-overfill pinch valves.

- The baghouses on top of the silos allow air to escape through the filters.
- The baghouses are required to be inspected at least once a month
- A complete set of bags must be kept in stock at all facility for the bag houses.
- An alarm is present, functional and will sound in the event of the overloading of a silo from a cement bulker, this will allow time to stop the overfill and to prevent a cement or fly ash discharge in to the atmosphere which could cause an environmental hazard and violation.

If any cementitious material is discharged in to the atmosphere, the Environmental Mgr. must be notified immediately. The Environmental Mgr. will notify the FDEP of the discharge, and fill out the required paper work.


