The Department has received the Title V General Permit Notification Form for the dry cleaning facility that you submitted on March 12, 2007.



Instructions for Completing Part III of Notification Form

The Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaning Facility Notification of Intent to Use General Permit, Part III of this form, shall be completed and submitted to the Division of Air Resources Management **at least 30 days prior to beginning operations under the general permit.** Please type or print clearly all information. A copy of this notification form shall be kept on-site and made available for review by Department personnel.

The responsible official of the facility, as defined in Part II of this notification form, is responsible for ensuring that the facility complies with all applicable terms and conditions of this general permit, as set forth in Part II of this form.

Facility Name and Location

1. **Facility Owner/Company Name** - Enter the name of the corporation, agency, or individual that has ownership or control of the dry cleaning facility for which this notification is submitted.
2. **Site Name** - Enter the common name, if any, of the facility site; for example, Plant A, Metropolis plant, etc. If more than one facility is owned, a notification form must be completed for each.
3. **Hazardous Waste Generator Identification Number** - Enter the hazardous waste generator identification number, if known, assigned by the Department to the facility.

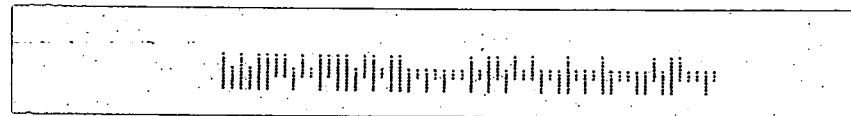
