Dear Mr. Ventimeglia:

Thank you for your January 5 letter notifying the Department of your change in drycleaning solvent type. The Department has made note that Capri Cleaners (AIRS ID #1030303) no longer uses perchloroethylene and your facility status has been changed to "Inactive."

The Title V General Permit program regulates drycleaning facilities using perchloroethylene. At this time, facilities using Exon 2000 are exempt from regulation.

Rule 62-213.300, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), stipulates that an annual emissions fee is due and payable for the preceding year in which the facility was in operation and subject to the requirements of the general permit. Our records indicate that Capri Cleaners operated as a Title V general permit facility in 2001. The emissions fee payment deposited on December 31 satisfies the emissions fee payment for Year 2001.
