Mr. Thomas:

Based on a June 20, 2006 inspection at Spirit Cleaners, LLC, dba , which is located at 3032 State Road. 590, Clearwater, FL. This facility is shutdown for Perchloroethylene dry-to-dry operations. The inspection findings indicate that:

- 1) Perchloroethylene dry cleaning equipment is no longer on the premises.
- 2) The new Hydrocarbon dry cleaning and 40HP boiler operation are considered exempt from air permits.
- 3) Air Quality intends to deactivate this facility from its tracking files and awaits confirmation from your office that it has been deactivated in the ARMS system.
