The Department has received the Title V General Permit Notification Form for the dry cleaning facility that you submitted on January 2, 2002.



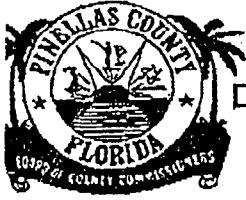

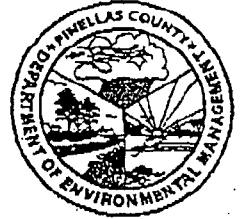

Mr. Song:

Pursuant to Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes, and the rules promulgated therein, which authorizes and empowers the Pinellas County Department of Environmental Management to control, abate and prohibit pollution of the air in Pinellas County, Florida, you are hereby notified of findings which indicate that a violation may have taken place of the Pinellas County Ordinance as follows:

On the basis of an inspection performed on April 21, 1997, by Pinellas County staff at *Fashion Cleaners*, this serves as a Advisory Letter. These deficiencies were discussed with you during the exit interview. Please make corrections to the following:

Corrective Actions Needed:

- 1) The responsible official shall maintain on-site, a start-up, shutdown, and malfunction (SSM) plan for the facility that describes in detail procedures for operating and maintaining the equipment during periods of start-up, shutdown, and malfunction. The plan shall also specify corrective action for malfunctioning process and air pollution control equipment. A SSM plan was not developed by the facility. Pursuant to Pinellas County Ordinance No. 97-05, Section 88, Sec.58-205.29
- ★ 2) A leak detection and repair inspection of the facility must be conducted and recorded on a weekly basis. The facility did not maintain the leak log on a weekly basis. Pursuant to Pinellas County Ordinance No. 97-05, Section 88, Sec.58-205.29

- 3) On the first business day of the month, the responsible official shall record the total amount of perchloroethylene purchased in the previous month and calculate the total amount purchased in the preceding twelve months, as a measure of perchloroethylene consumption. This record has not been maintained. Pursuant to Pinellas County Ordinance No. 97-05, Section 88, Sec.58-205.29.
- ✱ 4) The evaporator for separator wastewater does not incorporate a pre-filtration system. Separator water can be removed as hazardous waste, or pre-filtered through a carbon filtration system as per guidance memo ("Management of Drycleaning Separator Water") by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection dated December 9, 1996. Separator wastewater is currently evaporated into the atmosphere. The facility has agreed to install a pre-filtration system for separator wastewater by May 31, 1997.

Please provide a written response, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this letter, providing information, and copies of documentation that will demonstrate that the deficiencies cited above have been corrected.

The purpose of this letter is to avoid formal enforcement action and the possible judicial imposition of civil penalties, pursuant to Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes.


