Mr. Dibble:

Based on an October 7, 2008 inspection at Scott's Northwood Cleaners located at 2454 McMullen Booth Road, Clearwater, FL this facility shutdown the Perchloroethylene dry-to-dry operations. Inspection findings indicate that:

- 1) The previous facility owner, James R Scott was not present at the time of the inspection a different owner is currently in possession of the building space. The facility is now known as Spirit Cleaners. Spirit Cleaners occupies this facility as a drop store only.
- 2) Air Quality has received correspondence from Spirit Cleaners owner, Margie Rutherford requesting the permit be rescinded. Technically due to new ownership the previous permit is no longer valid. (See attached copy)
- 3) The Perchloroethylene equipment was observed to no longer be on the premises.
- 4) Air Quality intends to deactivate this facility from its tracking files and awaits confirmation from your office that it has been deactivated in the ARMS system.

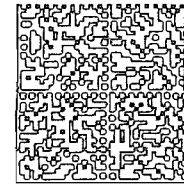

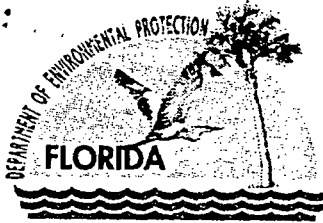

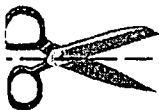

The Department of Environmental Protection records show Spirit Cleaners, LLC as active for use of a general permit for the operation of Existing, Large Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaning Facility: Miraclear 165 RPFS (1984) Machine and a Rerzacci/Sereno-Surssso (1982) Machine. The permit would not expire until 2/12/11. Both of these machines were removed from site as observed by Pinellas County Air Quality staff on 6/20/2006.

You also have acquired the Scott's Northwood Cleaners, which is use as one of your drop stores. The Economatic 3226 dry to dry equipment has been non functional and disconnected, as observed by our staff on 12/13/2007. 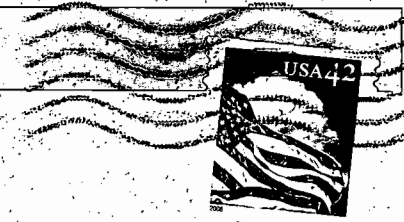

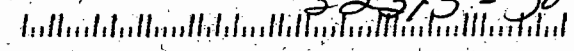
