Description of Facility :

Our facility in the paint refinishing area contains two areas one for cabinet refinishing and another for automotive type refinishing.

Cabinet refinishing: This area we receive laminated cabinets including doors and we sand these cabinets and doors and apply a sealer coat onto the cabinet then sanded. We then apply a several coats of automotive clear coat for a final finish. We then sand and buff cabinets to a final luster. The application of sealer and clear coat is applied inside of an approved spray booth with dual filtration. The filters are changed frequently to assure clean air for the atmosphere and air quality for the booth.

Automotive refinishing: This area is used for the refinishing and collision type work on recreational vehicles. We have a prepping station where all body work and fiberglass is done. Once the unit is prepped it is put into an approved spray booth with dual filtration and the coach is painted and clear coated. Once the coach is completed it is removed from the booth and taken to our detail area for buffing as needed then washed. The spray booths are always properly maintained by cleaning and changing filters as needed.

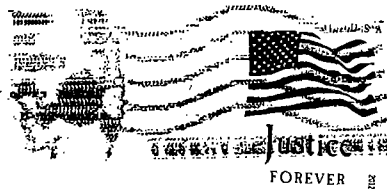
