2) WE HAVE AN ONSITE SWEEPER THAT SWEEPS ALL PAVED AREAS AS NEEDED.

3) THERE IS AN 8' CONCRETE WALL AROUND PROPERTY LINE WITH AN ADDITIONAL 8' WIND BREAK AT PROPERTY LINE.

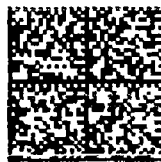
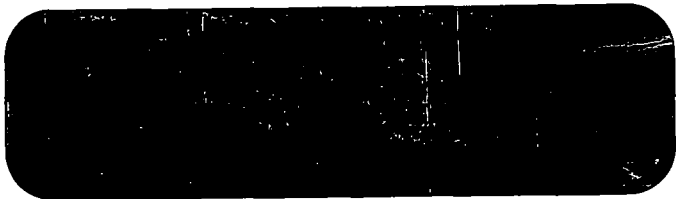
4) WE HAVE SPRAY BARS AT SPECIFIC POINTS ON THE CRUSHER.

5) OUR PILES ARE KEPT AT REASONABLE HEIGHT TO MINIMIZE WIND EFFECT.

FACILITY IS A BOHRINGER PRIMARY IMPACT CRUSHER PRODUCING 200 TONS/DAY. WATER IS INTRODUCED TO MINIMIZE DUST AT INPUT POINT JUST BEFORE ENTERING IMPACTOR. THE MATERIAL IS SPRAYED AGAIN AS IT LEAVES THE IMPACTOR AND TRANSPORTED TO A SCREEN DECK WHERE MATERIAL SIZES ARE SEPERATED. AFTER BEING SEPERATED, MATERIALS ARE SPRAYED AGAIN AND TRANSPORTED TO STACKER CONVEYORS WHERE MATERIALS ARE NOW STOCKPILED. TRUCK LOADING AREAS ARE CONSTANTLY WETTED TO MINIMIZE DUST AT ALL TIMES DURING THE DAY.



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
