This facility, known as Rock Crusher No. 1, bears Woodruff & Sons Equipment ID No. 1228 and is covered under General Permit 7771101-008-AG. The main unit bears Seral Number 10482. It consists of an Eagle Model 1400 Crusher and its associated conveyor belts and stackers. The unit is relocatable and reconfigurable. Rock and waste concrete to be crushed are placed into the crusher by backhoe or front end loader. The oversize material is returned to the entrance by conveyor and the properly sized material is either sent to a screener or to storage. The unit is sometimes located in a yard that also has a permitted soil cement plant present.




