

Crush-It, Inc. strives to maintain a high level of dust control at each job site. We keep traffic at a low speed in the yards and keep roadways around the crusher and equipment watered to suppress dust. Crush-It, Inc. requires our customers to have water available at each job location. Also, we have newer, efficient tier 3 diesel engines. Crush-It, Inc. has a low employee turn-over rate which means our employees are highly skilled at their jobs, each familiar with the crusher and accompanying equipment.

Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the nonmetallic mineral processing operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used.

The daily process with which the crusher and our crews perform are as follows:

1. The excavator loosens and sorts the rubble pile which can consist of either concrete or asphalt.
2. The loader then scoops up the loosened and sorted rubble pile and drops the material in the feed hopper of the crusher.
3. The material is then run through the crusher and screened.
4. After screening, the material is deposited onto the radial stacker and stockpiled.

Water is continually running during the crusher process to eliminate dust. We normally have a 4-man crew consisting of a crusher operator, loader operator, excavator operator and laborer.

The following is a detailed description of our equipment:

1. Eagle 1200 Crusher, serial number 22338
Capacity in T/HR is less than 150 tons per hour
2. Crusher power unit is a John Deere, serial number 014788, 325 HP
3. Screening operation consists of Simplicity 80 FT2, serial number 2516-M110B, model number M110B with the same fuel type as the power unit.

There is no screening operation power unit because the screening operation is not a stand-alone unit.

Dear Mr. Wohlwend,

The Nonmetallic Mineral Processing (NMMP) Plant Air General Permit (AGP) rules require that certain information be provided when registering for the NMMP Plant AGP.

Florida Administrative Code - Rule 62-210.310(5)(e)6., F.A.C.

6. The registration for this air general permit shall include all the following information.

- a. The type of facility (stationary or relocatable).
- b. The precautions to be used to prevent unconfined emissions of particulate matter from roads, parking areas, stock piles, and yards (one or more of the following: pave roads; pave parking areas; pave yards; maintain roads/parking/yards; use water application; use dust suppressant; remove particulate matter; reduce stock pile height; or install wind breaks).
- c. The location of spray bars (one or more of the following: feeders; entrance to crushing operation; exit of crushing operation; classifier screens; or conveyor drop points).
- d. For each emission unit, component description (primary crusher, secondary crusher, screener, conveyor, reciprocating internal combustion engine, or other fuel burning equipment), manufacturer, date of manufacture, model number, serial number, and rated capacity (tons per hour material throughput or horsepower).

Dear Mr. Richardson,

I am in receipt of your renewal registration for the Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plant Air General Permit operation/unit currently located @ the 6000 E Hanna Ave location in Tampa.

On page 10 of the registration, under Description of Facility, #1. you have indicated that the "Eagle 1200 Crusher, serial number 22338 Capacity in T/HR is **less than 150 tons per hour**". Before I can complete the review and processing of your registration, I will need to know the actual "machine-rated capacity" (50 t/hr, 75 t/hr, 100 t/hr, or 125 t/hr or whatever the rating is) specific to your Eagle 1200 Series Crusher. "Machine-rated capacity" is defined as the maximum processing capability of the unit, expressed in tons per hour, regardless of the material being processed. Many of the 1200 Series machines can have "machine-rated capacities" greater than 150 T/hr and are capable of up to 300 and 600 T/hr depending on the series model.

If you would be so kind to reply by e-mail and I will simply attach your e-mail as an addendum to your current registration and I can continue with the review and processing of your registration.

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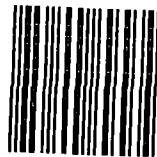
