
This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on October 15, 2008. We have assigned ARMS No. 7775544-001 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty (30) days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after five (5) years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than five (5) years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.

The unit is a Titan 1800 Deck Screener that sorts processed nonmetailic minerals (materials) by size such as reclaimed asphalt, gravel, and concrete.

1. Material received from trucks or a crusher is dumped on the ground in outdoor storage piles.
2. Emission Point Number 1:
  - A. Material is transferred from outdoor storage piles to the deck screener or by a conveyor belt of a crusher to the deck screener for sorting.
3. Emission point number 1, top of screener: Material is dropped directly into the shaker/screener.
4. Emission Point Number 2: From the bottom of the screener, the unwated material drops onto the ground.
5. Emission Point Number 3: The wanted material is sent on a conveyor to be stockpiled or to a crusher for further processing.
