For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after five (5) years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than five (5) years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.

This is a registration for a 1412 Tracpactor, Serial Number 140175DH non-metallic mineral processing machine (Rock Crusher). The Tracpactor was manufactured by BL-Pegson in 2006, and is powered by a 520 Hp diesel Cat C-13 engine, Serial Number LGK01874. This machine also utilizes a MGL Model 7436 Conveyor Belt with a 74 hp motor for power The rated capacity is 275 tons per hour. It is planned to use this machine to recycle concrete and crush virgin rock. The equipment is presently located on CEMEX property in Miami.
