There is no integral screen on this machine, only a feeder grizzly. It is powered by a Caterpillar C-10 manufactured in October of 2008. There are two conveyor belts associated with this machine. The belts are manufactured by Metso, the main belt is 10' x 24", the side conveyor is 5' x 24". The machine will be used to process recycled materials, concrete, asphalt, assorted bulding materials, limestone, granite and other aggregate products
