Helpful Definitions

"Emissions Unit" - Any part or activity of a facility that emits or has the potential to emit any air pollutant.

"Facility" - All of the emissions units which are located on one or more contiguous or adjacent properties, and which are under the control of the same person (or persons under common control).

"Owner" or "Operator" - Any person or entity who or which owns, leases, operates, controls or supervises an emissions unit or facility.

"Polyester Resin Material" - Materials used in polyester resin operations which include isophthalic, orthophthalic, halogenated, bisphenol-A, vinyl-ester or furan resins; cross-linking agents; catalysts, gel coats, inhibitors, accelerators; promoters, and any other VOC containing materials.

"Reinforced Polyester Resin Operations" - An operation that entails saturating a reinforcing material such as glass fiber with a polyester resin material. Such operations include the production or rework of product by mixing, pouring, hand laying-up, impregnating, injecting, forming, spraying, and/or curing unsaturated polyester materials with fiberglass, fillers, or any other reinforcement materials and associated cleanup.

When contacted, you may be required to submit in writing the steps which you have taken to ensure that no further violation(s) will occur. Said report may include evidence of equipment repairs, adjustments or servicing performed to correct the violation(s).
- Within ___ days of receipt of this NOTICE, submit a completed application for an air construction/operating permit to ERM Air Quality Management located at the above letterhead address.
- Within 10 days of receipt of this NOTICE, submit the required documents/records/reports to ERM Air Quality Management Staff.

Be advised that applying for an ERM Air Permit does not necessarily guarantee the issuance of such Permit, and you may not be allowed to continue operation at this location.

Failure to comply with the above may result in either the issuance of a uniform Civil Violation Notice (UCVN), pursuant to Chapter 8-CC of Miami-Dade County, requiring corrective action(s) and payment of a civil penalty or the initiation of formal enforcement action by this Department, subjecting you to the enforcement and penalty provisions of Sections 24-29 and 24-30 of the Code of Miami-Dade County.
