Crushed material goet up to screen, where material is either screened out to the finished product conveyor, or recirculated back into the crusher. This recirculated material goes through the crushing screening process until it is the desired size. Once the material is sized correctly, the finished product travels on a conveyor and drops into a pile. Finished product is then picked up by a loader and put into the stockpile.
