Dear Ms. Harris:

This letter is intended to make testing and renewal date corrections to permit 0050026001AO to operate wallpaper/fabric print lines.

By this letter permit 0050026001AO is amended as follows:

Specific Condition No. 6 is changed from:

4. Visible emissions tests are required to show continuing compliance with the standards of the Department. The test results must provide reasonable assurance that the source is capable of compliance at the normal maximum operating rate. Tests shall be conducted in accordance with DEP Method 9. Such tests shall be conducted once in 2001 within 60 days of the baseline date of September 30. Results shall be submitted to the Department within 45 days after testing. The Department shall be notified at least 15 days prior to testing to allow witnessing. [FAC Rule 62-297.330]

to:

4. Visible emissions tests are required to show continuing compliance with the standards of the Department. The test results must provide reasonable assurance that the source is capable of compliance at the normal maximum operating rate. Tests shall be conducted in accordance with DEP Method 9. Such tests shall be conducted once in 2000 within 60 days of the baseline date of December 31. Results shall be submitted to the Department within 45 days after testing. The Department shall be notified at least 15 days prior to testing to allow witnessing. [FAC Rule 62-297.330]

"Protect, Conserve and Manage Florida's Environment and Natural Resources"

Specific Condition No. 7 is changed from:

7. An application to renew this permit shall be submitted prior to January 1, 2001. [FAC Rule 62-4.090]

to:

7. At least sixty days prior to the expiration of this permit, the permittee shall submit to the Department an air permit application in quadruplicate, DEP Form No. 62-210.900(2), along with any applicable fees as established in FAC Rule 62-4.050(4). [FAC Rule 62-4.090(1)].

All other Specific Conditions of this permit remain in effect. This letter shall be attached to and made part of permit 0050026001AO.

This permit is issued under the provisions of Section 403.087, Florida Statutes, and Florida Administrative Code Rules 62-296, 62-297 and 62-4. The above named applicant, hereinafter called Permittee, is hereby authorized to perform the work or operate the facility shown on the application and approved drawing(s), plans, and other documents attached hereto or on file with the Department and made a part hereof and specifically described as follows:

Operation of a Wallpaper/Fabric Print Lines. The wallpaper print line has a natural gas fueled oven, manufactured by Stork, model PD-3. The fabric print line consists of two printers with two natural gas fueled dryers, steam-wash-dryer and tenter frames. The flue gases and process fumes from both lines are manifolded together and vented through north and south stacks. A fume eliminator, manufactured by CVM, model 120-DTR-12 is used to reduce fumes. VOC's from the plastasols used in the manufacturing of the wallpaper are 14.2 TPY, of which 0.77 TPY are from phosphorous and 0.052 TPY are from arsenic.

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SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

GENERAL

1. The attached General Conditions are part of this permit. [FAC Rule 62-4.160]

OPERATION

2. Hours of operation are limited to 6000 hours per year. [FAC Rule 62-4.070(3), Construction permit application emission calculations]

EMISSION

3. Visible emissions shall not be equal to or greater than 20% opacity. [FAC Rule 62-296.310(2)]
4. All fugitive dust generated at this site shall be adequately controlled. [FAC Rule 62-296.310]
5. No objectionable odors shall be allowed off plant property. If the Department determines the facility is emitting objectionable odors, the Permittee shall submit an odor remediation plan within 45 days of receipt of written notification from the Department. The plan shall include, but not be limited to, dispersion modeling analysis, strategies to reduce odorous chemicals utilization, and modifications of manufacturing production cycles, manufacturing methods and/or plant exhaust systems. [FAC Rule 62-296.320(2)]

TESTING

6. Visible emissions tests are required to show continuing compliance with the standards of the Department. The test results must provide reasonable assurance that the source is capable of compliance at the normal maximum operating rate. Tests shall be conducted in accordance with DER Method 9. Such tests shall be conducted once in 2001 within 60 days of the baseline date of September 30. Results shall be submitted to the Department within 45 days after testing. The Department shall be notified at least 15 days prior to testing to allow witnessing. [FAC Rule 62-297.330]

ADMINISTRATIVE

7. An application to renew this permit shall be submitted prior to January 1, 2001. [FAC Rule 62-4.090]
8. The permanent source identification number for this point source is 0050026001. Please cite this number on all test reports and other correspondence specific to this permitted point source. [FAC Rule 62-297.570]

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
