

FINAL DETERMINATION

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. APPLICANT

B. PROJECT

This permit is for the replacement of the four existing thermal afterburners of EU-506 – Batch Roasters with four catalytic afterburners.

II. FINAL DETERMINATION

The Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination for the project described above was distributed on March 29, 2007. The Notice of Intent to Issue was published in the Financial News and Daily Record on April 2, 2007.

Copies of the evaluation were available for public inspection at the Environmental Resource Management Department, Environmental Quality Division (Department), and Department of Environmental Protection, Northeast District offices.

Comments were received and the DRAFT Construction Permit was not changed. The comments were not considered significant enough to reissue the DRAFT Permit and require another Public Notice. Comments were received from one (1) respondent during the 14 (fourteen) day public comment period. The comment(s) will not be restated. Where duplicative comments exist, the original response is referenced.

A. Comments – Mr. Raymond Jenks E-Mail from Mr. Jenks received April 15, 2007

Comment 1: How many roasters are in service?

Response: The four (4) new afterburners will be replacements for the existing four (4) Batch Roasters' afterburners. The facility has two (2) Thermal Roasters, ten (10) Probat Roasters and one (1) Continuous Roaster in addition to the Batch Roasters. Each roaster is equipped with an afterburner.

Comment 1: Will the new afterburners minimize odors and particulate matter emissions?

Response: The new afterburners are expected to be more efficient in reducing the emissions from the Batch Roasters.

III. CONCLUSION

The final action of the Department will be to issue Construction Permit 0310004-015-AC as proposed in the Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination.
