Enclosed is Permit Number 0310188-011-AF for the subject air pollution source, issued pursuant to Section 403.087, Florida Statutes (F.S.).

This facility is subject to the applicable sections of 40CFR63, Subpart A, General Provisions, and 40CFR63, Subpart JJJJJJ, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional Boilers - Area Sources.

40CFR63, Subpart JJJJJJ has not been adopted by the State of Florida or the City of Jacksonville. The requirements of this standard will not be placed in the air operation permit until it is adopted by the State of Florida and the City of Jacksonville. However, this facility is still responsible for compliance with this standard. The Environmental Protection Agency, Region 4 (EPA) is responsible for ensuring compliance with this standard. 
