Minor Source Air Construction Permit  
300 HP Boiler No.10 Installation

This is the final air construction permit, which authorizes Reichhold, Inc., to install a new 300 HP Natural Gas Fired Boiler. The proposed work will be conducted at the Pensacola Plant, which is an existing Plastic Material and Synthetic Resins Facility (Standard Industrial Classification No. 2821). The facility is located in Escambia County at 425 South Pace Boulevard in Pensacola, Florida. The UTM coordinates are Zone 16, 476.4 km East, and 3363.9 km North. As noted in the Final Determination provided with this final permit, no changes were made to the draft permit.

Because of the technical nature of the project, the permit contains numerous acronyms and abbreviations, which are defined in Appendix A of Section 4 of this permit.

This air pollution construction permit is issued under the provisions of: Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-296 and 62-297 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The permittee is authorized to conduct the proposed work in accordance with the conditions of this permit. This project is subject to the general preconstruction review requirements in Rule 62-212.300, F.A.C., and is not subject to the preconstruction review requirements for major stationary sources in Rule 62-212.400, F.A.C., for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) of Air Quality.

Upon issuance of this final permit, any party to this order has the right to seek judicial review of it under Section 120.68 of the Florida Statutes by filing a notice of appeal under Rule 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with the clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection in the Office of General Counsel (Mail Station #35, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000) and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The notice must be filed within 30 days after this order is filed with the clerk of the Department.
