This is the final air operation permit which authorizes Golf Agronomics Supply and Handling to operate a Sand Drying and Crusher System consisting of a Vibrating Fluid Bed Sand Dryer, Screen, Conveyors, Storage Silos and a Truck Loadout System. (The system includes one “Relocatable” Sand Crusher that is permitted on a separate permit (Permit No. 7774821-002-AG). The operation is at the Witherspoon Sand Plant which is a Standard Industrial Classification No. 3299. Two ground level storage areas (12’W x 16’D x 8’H) framed with cement “bin blocks” and tarped (only produce fugitive emissions) can be utilized for small production usage and are exempt due to insignificant emissions under FDEP Rule 62-4.040(1)(b) F.A.C. The facility is located in Glades County at 11655 SR 78 in Moore Haven, Florida. The UTM coordinates are Zone 17, 477.5 km East, and 2965.67 km North.

This final operating permit is organized by the following sections:

- Section 2. Administrative Requirements
- Section 3. Emissions Unit Specific Conditions
- Section 4. Appendices

Because of the technical nature of the project, the permit contains numerous acronyms and abbreviations, which are defined in Appendix A of Section 4 of this permit.

This air pollution operation permit is issued under the provisions of: Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-296 and 62-297 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The permittee is authorized to operate the facility in accordance with the conditions of this permit. This project is subject to the general preconstruction review requirements in Rule 62-212.300, F.A.C. and is not subject to the preconstruction review requirements for major stationary sources in Rule 62-212.400, F.A.C. for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) of Air Quality.

Upon issuance of this final permit, any party to this order has the right to seek judicial review of it under Section 120.68 of the Florida Statutes by filing a notice of appeal under Rule 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with the clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection in the Office of General Counsel (Mail Station #35, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000) and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The notice must be filed within 30 days after this order is filed with the clerk of the Department.
