Hall N Barnes Lane Facility
Minor Source Air Construction Permit
Air Curtain Incinerator

This is the final air construction permit, which authorizes the construction of an Air Curtain Incinerator. The proposed work will be conducted at an existing Yard Trash Transfer Station/Solid Waste Organics Recycling Facility, the Hall N Barnes facility (Standard Industrial Classification No. 4953, Refuse Systems). The facility is located at Leon County at Hall N Barnes Lane, northeast of the intersection of Hill N Dale Road and Buck Lake Road in Tallahassee, Florida. The UTM coordinates are Zone 16, 775.2 km East, and 3399.6 km North. As noted in the Final Determination provided with this final permit, no changes were made to the draft permit.

Because of the technical nature of the project, the permit contains numerous acronyms and abbreviations, which are defined in Appendix A of Section 4 of this permit.

This air pollution construction permit is issued under the provisions of: Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-296 and 62-297 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The permittee is authorized to conduct the proposed work in accordance with the conditions of this permit. This project is subject to the general preconstruction review requirements in Rule 62-212.300, F.A.C., and is not subject to the preconstruction review requirements for major stationary sources in Rule 62-212.400, F.A.C., for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) of Air Quality.

Upon issuance of this final permit, any party to this order has the right to seek judicial review of it under Section 120.68 of the Florida Statutes by filing a notice of appeal under Rule 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with the clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection in the Office of General Counsel (Mail Station #35, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000) and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The notice must be filed within 30 days after this order is filed with the clerk of the Department.
