Dear Mr. Enochs:

On **May 9, 2017**, United Technologies Corporation requested an extension of the expiration date of air construction Permit No. 0990021-049-AC for the United Technologies Corporation located in Palm Beach County at 17900 Beeline Highway (SR-710) in Jupiter, Florida. United Technologies Corporation requests the additional time to allow for the construction of 3 Plasma booths that will complete construction and be ready and operational by the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2018. In addition several months are also required to “qualify” the new booths to the customer. The new booths can only be used on production engine parts after the qualification trials. Based on the circumstances and information provided, the Health Department approves this request.

*The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has permitting jurisdiction under Section 403.087, Florida Statutes (F.S.). However, in accordance with Section 403.182, F.S., the DEP recognizes the Florida Department of Health Palm Beach County (Health Department) as the approved local air pollution control program of Palm Beach County. Through a Specific Operating Agreement, the DEP authorized the Health Department to issue or deny permits for this type of air pollution source located in Palm Beach County*

**Permitting Authority:** Applications for air construction permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210, and 62-212 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and an air permit is required to perform the proposed work. The in the Florida Department of Health Palm Beach County is the Permitting Authority responsible for making a determination for this project. The Permitting Authority’s physical address is: 800 Clematis St, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, West Palm Beach, Florida. The Permitting Authority’s mailing address is: 800 Clematis St, P.O. Box 29, West Palm Beach, Florida 33402-0029. The Permitting Authority’s telephone number is 561-837-5900.

## EXTENSION OF AIR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT EXPIRATION DATE

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**Determination:** The expiration date is hereby extended from May 31, 2017 to May 31, 2018 to provide the necessary time to complete construction. This permitting action does not authorize any new construction. A copy of this letter shall be filed with the referenced permit and shall become part of the permit. This permitting decision is issued pursuant to Chapter 403, Florida Statutes.

**Petitions:** A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. Petitions must be filed within 14 days of receipt of this permit extension. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Permitting Authority's action is based must contain the following information: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known; (b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner; the name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of when and how each petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed decision; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact; (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to the specific rules or statutes; and, (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this written notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

**Mediation:** Mediation is not available in this proceeding.

**Effective Date:** This permitting decision is final and effective on the date filed with the clerk of the Department unless a petition is filed in accordance with the above paragraphs or unless a request for extension of time in which to file a petition is filed within the time specified for filing a petition pursuant to Rule 62-110.106, F.A.C., and the petition conforms to the content requirements of Rules 28-106.201 and 28-106.301, F.A.C. Upon timely filing of a petition or a request for extension of time, this action will not be effective until further order of the Department.

**Judicial Review:** Any party to this Final Order has the right to seek judicial review pursuant to Section 120.68, F.S., by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with the Health Department at the address listed below; and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Health Department.



Pratt & Whitney respectfully requests an extension for the current construction permit, FDEP Permit No. 0990021-049-AC CAN Expansion Project, which expires on May 31, 2017.

We currently have 3 plasma spray booths under construction and estimate that all 3 booths will complete construction and be ready for operational status by first quarter of 2018.

Construction will be completed somewhat earlier but after construction, several months are required to “qualify” the new booths to our primary customer, the U. S. government. The new booths can be used on production engine parts only after qualification trials

Therefore we request an extension of the construction permit. We are requesting the construction permit expiration be extended to May 31, 2018.
