This is the final air operation permit for an existing abrasive blasting facility. The proposed work is conducted at the Alturas Facility (Standard Industrial Classification No. 1721). The facility is located in Polk County at 7621 Poinsettia Avenue in Bartow, Florida. The UTM coordinates are Zone 17, 429.6 km East, and 3082.9 km North. As noted in the Final Determination provided with this final permit, no changes or only minor changes and clarifications were made to the draft permit.



Due to the technical nature of the project, the permit contains numerous acronyms and abbreviations, which are defined in Appendix A of Section 4 of this permit.

This air pollution permit is issued under the provisions of: Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-296 and 62-297 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The permittee is authorized to conduct the proposed work in accordance with the conditions of this permit.

Upon issuance of this final permit, any party to this order has the right to seek judicial review of it under Section 120.68 of the Florida Statutes by filing a notice of appeal under Rule 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with the clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection in the Office of General Counsel (Mail Station #35, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000) and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The notice must be filed within 30 days after this order is filed with the clerk of the Department.


