With regard to your conversation with Chris Bradley of Progress Energy Florida, Inc. (PEF) and Scott Osbourn of Golder & Associates on the afternoon of Friday, September 17, 2010, PEF requests separate processing of the recently submitted Air Construction (AC) permit and Title V Operating Permit revision. Therefore, please withdraw the Title V portion of the application and remove the above reference permit application from the concurrent processing procedure, pursuant to Rule 62.213.405, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), which was requested when the application was submitted. PEF's understanding is that this action will result in the issuance of an air construction (AC) permit with a completeness review period of thirty (30) days. The 30-day clock begins upon the Department's receipt of the application. In addition, it is our understanding that once the AC is issued and any compliance requirements fulfilled, the Title V will then be revised.
