Applicant: The applicant for these projects is the City of Gainesville Gainesville Regional Utilities Deerhaven Generating Station, located at 10001 NW 18th Street, Gainesville, Alachua County. The applicant's responsible official is: Mr. Randy L. Casserly, R.G., D.R., and Interim Assistant General Manager of Energy Supply, City of Gainesville, Gainesville Regional Utilities, Deerhaven Generating Station, 10001 NW 18th Street, Gainesville, Florida 32602.
Facility Location: The applicant operates the Deerhaven Generating Station, which is an electrical utility plant and located at 10001 NW 18th Street, Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida.
Project: On July 2, 2004, the applicant applied to the Permitting Authority for a Title V air operation permit (Permit) renewal. On September 23, 2004, via facsimile, the applicant applied for an air construction permit (AC). Details of the project are provided in the application and the enclosed "Statement of Basis" for the Permit renewal, and the Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination, for the AC.

The AC is being issued to remove some federally enforceable nitrogen oxides limitations (lb/hr and TPD) that have no rule basis and are essentially equivalent emissions to the BACT standards established in the PSD Permit, No. PSD-FL-212, and its BACT Determination for combustion turbine (CT) No. 3 (these conditions were also established in the Power Plant Siting Act Conditions of Certification, No. PA 74-04). In addition, the AC is being issued to establish that the existing continuous emissions monitoring system (CEMS) for nitrogen oxides for CT No. 2 will be used for continuous compliance and, therefore, not subject to compliance assurance monitoring (CAM) requirements.

The Permit renewal is being issued to allow continued commercial operation of the facility, as authorized by the initial Permit, No. 0010006-003-AV, and the Permit revision, No. 0010006-002-AV. For the Permit renewal, CAM does apply to Boiler No. 2.

Permitting Authority: Applications for Permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Chapters 62-4, 62-310, 62-513 and 62-214, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and a Permit is required to operate the facility. The Department's Bureau of Air Regulation is the Permitting Authority responsible for making a Permit determination regarding this project. The Permitting Authority's physical address is 111 South Magnolia Drive, Suite 4, Tallahassee, Florida 32301. The applicant has provided reasonable assurance that operation of the facility will not adversely impact air quality and that the project will comply with all appropriate provisions of Chapters 62-4, 62-304, 62-210, 62-212, 62-213, 62-214, 62-254, 62-267, 62-261, 62-296, and 62-207, F.A.C. ORDINANCE TITLE ORDINANCE NO. 040485 9-24-04

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville amending section 2-67 of the Gainesville Code of Ordinances by clarifying the mayor's source of authority for declaring a state of emergency; authorizing the mayor pro tem to act if the mayor is unavailable; clarifying the penalties for violating provisions of emergency measures depending on the source of the authority; providing directions to the codifier providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

Note: "All persons are advised that, if any person decides to appeal any decision made at any of these meetings, they will need a record of the proceedings and for such purposes they need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based."

Written comments should be provided to the permitting authority office. If written comments received result in a significant change in this Draft AC, the permitting authority shall issue a Revised Draft AC and require, if applicable, another Public Notice. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection.

The Permitting Authority will accept written comments concerning the DRAFT permit for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of publication of the Public Notice. Written comments must be post-marked and all facsimile comments must be received by the close of business (5:00 pm), on or before the end of this 30-day period, by the Permitting Authority at the above address or facsimile. As part of his or her comments, any person may also request that the Permitting Authority hold a public meeting on this permitting action. If the Permitting Authority determines there is sufficient interest for a public meeting, it will publish notice of the time, date, and location of the Department's official web site for notices at <http://flhwa.de.state.fl.us/> and in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected by the permitting action. For additional information, contact the Permitting Authority at the above address or phone number. If written comments or comments received at a public meeting result in a significant change to the DRAFT Permit, the Permitting Authority shall issue a Revised Public Notice. All comments filed will be made available for public inspection.

Petitions: A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed with the Permitting Authority's Agency Clerk in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection at 2900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #25, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S., must be filed within fourteen (14) days of publication of this Public Notice or receipt of a written notice, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Permitting Authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen (14) days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 26-08 20E, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Permitting Authority's action is based must contain the following information: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known; (b) The name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of how and when the petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so state; (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 26-08 20E, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Public Notice of Intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation: Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

Objections: In addition to the above right to petition, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 786(d)(2)(C), any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within sixty (60) days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45 (forty-five) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 786(d)(2)(C), to object to the issuance of any Permit. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the Permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the thirty (30) day public comment period provided in the Public Notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or unusual grounds for such objection arose after the comment period. Filing of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any Permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Petitions filed with the Administrator of the EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 786(d)(2)(C) and must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA at: U.S. EPA, 401 M Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20460. 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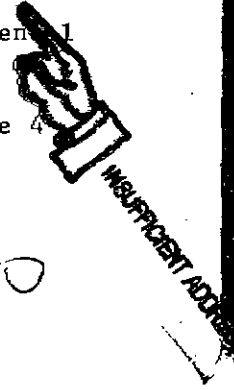
