

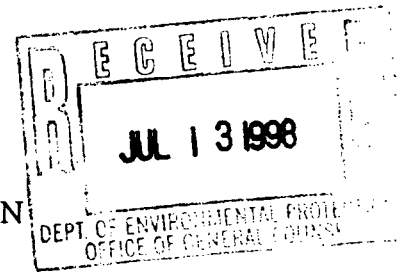

REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

By and through undersigned counsel, City of Gainesville, Gainesville Regional Utilities (GRU) hereby requests, pursuant to Florida Administrative Code Rules 28-106.111(3) and 62-103.050(1), an extension of time to and including August 14, 1998, in which to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings in the above-styled matter. As good cause for granting this request, GRU states the following:

1. On or about October 1, 1997, GRU received from the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) an "Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit" (Permit No. 0010006-001-AV) for the Deerhaven Generating Station in Alachua County, Florida. Along with the Intent to Issue, GRU received a draft Title V permit and "Public Notice of Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit."
2. The Department previously agreed to grant an extension until July 17, 1998, to file a petition in this matter.
3. Based on GRU's review, the draft permit and associated documents contain several provisions that warrant clarification or correction.
4. Representatives of GRU have corresponded and plan to continue to correspond

with staff of the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation in an effort to resolve its concerns regarding the draft permit.


5. This request is filed simply as a protective measure to avoid waiver of GRU's right to challenge certain conditions contained in the draft Title V permit. Grant of this request will not prejudice either party, but will further their mutual interest and likely avoid the need to file a petition and proceed to a formal administrative hearing.

6. Scott Sheplak with the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation has agreed to an extension until August 14, 1998, on behalf of the Department. Representatives from GRU have attempted without success to contact Jeffrey Brown with the Department's Office of General Counsel regarding this request.




