Dear Ms Phillips;

Hunter Marine is a major source of hazardous air pollutants and has received a Title V permit through FDEP Northeast District office for our Alachua, Florida operations located at 797 East Martin Luther King Blvd, Alachua, Florida 32615. Our facility is classified under SIC Code 3732 "Boat Building and Repairing".

This process involves molds, decks, hulls and metal fabrication, assembly, fiberglass reinforced plastics, wiring, painting, cabinetry, upholstery, trim, engine and accessories installation. The various processes are grouped into a single emission unit which are regulated by the promulgated NESHAP for "Boat Manufacturing" referenced in 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart VVVV. We feel that our facility, would only be regulated by this "single emission unit", however our facility may in the future be affected by the following source categories and associated NESHAPs;

Misc. Metal Parts and Products Surface Coating

Plastic Parts Surface Coating

This facility has not undergone a 112(g) case-by-case MACT determination.
