FRI requests permission

FRI requests permission to use SNCR in a test program from October 25 through December 31. 2004, that will allow the Department and FRI to determine the range of NOx emission reductions possible under multiple operating scenarios using SNCR. The proposed testing evaluation will not result in significant net emissions increases and a new evaluation under the rules for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) is not required.

The plant has continuous The plant has continuous emissions monitoring (CEM) equipment for NOX. SO2, opacity and total hydrocarbons as well as annual testing requirements for all of the regulated pollutants. The plant is subject to 40CFR63, Subpart LLL. As part of these tests, additional testing will be performed for particulate matter and visible emissions in conjunction with the CEM data.

The Department will issue the Final Permit (Letter) with the attached conditions unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions. The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed permit issuance action for a period of fourteen (14) days from the date of publication of this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, FL 32399-2400. Any written comments flee shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in asignificant change in the proposed agency action. The Department shall revise the proposed permit and require, if applicable another Public Notice.

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is lifed pursuant to Sections '120.589 and 120.57. F.S. before the deadline for filing a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below Mediation is not available in this proceeding.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Section 120.569 and 120.57. F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35. Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000. Petitions must be filed within fourteen (14) days of publication of this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit Under Section 120.69(3), F.S. however, petitions submitted by person(s) who asked the Department for notice of agency action must be filed within fourteen (14) days of receipt of that notice or the date of publication of the public notice whichever occurs first. A petitioner shall mail a copy of

The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120,559 and 120,51; F.S., or to intervene in the proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent, intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106,205. F.A.C.

If there are none, the petition must so indicate; (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or tends warrant reversal of modification of the agen-cy's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific statement of the specific rules or statutes the peti-tioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action, and (g) A state-ment of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action peti-tioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final action of the Department on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.
