Dear Dr. Koogler:


We received confirmation today from Deputy Secretary Green of his concurrence with our proposed use of low hydrocarbon containing mill scale. Secretary Green requires us to retest for VOC emissions using this new source of mill scale.

We are commencing to add mill scale to our raw mix and want to give the system sufficient time to reach chemical equilibrium, which may take up to a week. Depending on your availability of personnel and testing equipment, please schedule the retest for the week of October 9, 2000.

Relying on past practice, we believe you will notify the Northeast Division of DEP when testing will occur.
