**Facility Location:** The applicant operates the existing Argos Newberry Cement Plant, which is located in Alachua County at 4000 Northwest CR 235 in Newberry, Florida.

**Project:** Argos operates the existing Newberry Cement Plant, which includes a Portland cement plant and associated quarry, and raw material and cement handling operations. The applicant applied on June 4, 2014 to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Department) for a revised Title V air operation permit and concurrent air construction permit revision/modification for minor changes to previous conditions in the previously issued air construction permits and for the construction and installation of a new conveyor at the convey transfer point in the raw material handling and storage area. non-hazardous materials, such as identified above, and other alternative fuel materials engineered to have targeted, consistent fuel properties such as: heating value, moisture content, particle size, ash content, and volatility. The materials would be co-fired with coal to offset a portion of the coal needed to produce heat for the existing cement kilns.

Total emissions increases from the new equipment and the processing and handling of alternative fuels in Kiln Nos. 1 and 2 from all projects in this permit package are below the regulatory thresholds for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) program.

Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Permitting Authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within 14 days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing.
