This is in reference to your request dated July 28, 2014 for a one-year extension of the Mercury and Air Toxics Standards (MATS) compliance deadline for the coal-fueled units at Plant Crist and Plant Smith until April 16, 2016. The Department considers the request a substantial modification of the pending applications to renew the Title V applications for these facilities and has reset the initial processing clock. Pursuant to the Title V permitting regulations (Rule 62-213.420, F.A.C. and 403.0872, F.S.) and the general NESHAP provisions (40 CFR 63.1 and 40 CFR 63.9(i)), the Department will complete its review and request any additional information, if necessary, by 09/26/14.
