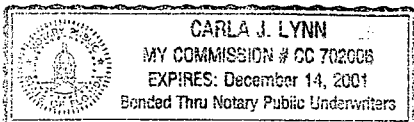

The Department of Envi-
ronmental Protection
(permitting authority) gives
notice of its intent to issue
a Title V air operation per-
mit revision to Bay County
for the Bay Resource Man-
agement Center located at
6510 Bay Line Drive, Pana-
ma City, Bay County, Bay
Industrial Park - approxi-
mately 2 miles North of the
intersection of U.S. 231

and County Road 2301.
The revision reflects a
change of auxiliary fuel
use from distillate fuel oil
to natural gas. The appli-
cant's name and address
are: Mr. Jonathan A.
Mantay, Bay County Board
of County Commissioners
310 West Sixth Street,
Panama City, Florida
32401.

The permitting authority
will issue the Title V PRO-
POSED Permit Revision,
and subsequent Title V FI-
NAL Permit Revision, in ac-
cordance with the condi-
tions of the Title V DRAFT
Permit Revision unless a
response received in ac-
cordance with the follow-
ing procedures results in a
different decision or signifi-
cant change of terms or
conditions. The permitting
authority will accept written
comments concerning the
proposed Title V DRAFT
Permit Revision issuance
action for a period of 30
(thirty) days from the date
of publication of this No-
tice. Written comments
should be provided to the
Department's Bureau of Air
Regulation, 2600 Blair
Stone Road, Mail Station
#5505, Tallahassee, Flori-
da 32399-2400. Any writ-
ten comments filed shall
be made available for pub-
lic inspection. If written
comments received result
in a significant change in
this DRAFT Permit Revi-
sion, the permitting author-
ity shall issue another Re-
vised DRAFT Permit Revi-
sion and require, if appli-
cable, another Public No-
tice.

A person whose substan-
tial interests are affected
by the proposed per-
mitting decision may peti-
tion for an administrative
hearing in accordance with
Sections 120.569 and
120.57 of the Florida Stat-
utes (F.S.). The petition

at 42 U.S.C. Section
7661d(b)(1), to object to
issuance of any permit.
Any petition shall be
based only on objections
to the permit that were
raised with reasonable
specificity during the 30
(thirty) day public com-
ment period provided in
the notice, unless the peti-
tioner demonstrates to the
Administrator of the EPA
that it was impracticable to
raise such objections with-
in the comment period or
unless the grounds for
such objection arose after
the comment period. Filing
of a petition with the Ad-
ministrator of the EPA
does not stay the effective
date of any permit properly
issued pursuant to the pro-
visions of Chapter 62-213,
F.A.C. Petitions filed with
the Administrator of EPA
must meet the require-
ments of 42 U.S.C. Section
7661d(b)(2) and must be
filed with the Administrator
of the EPA at: U.S. EPA,
401 M Street, S.W., Wash-
ington, D.C. 20460.

tion during normal busi-
ness hours, 8:00 a.m. to
5:00 p.m., Monday
through Friday, except le-
gal holidays, at:

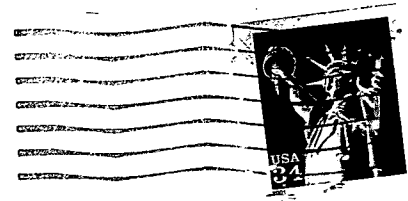
