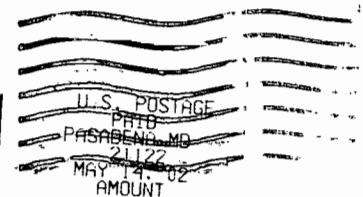

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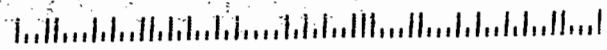

The project consists of four dual fuel combustion turbines and two 1.8 million-gallon tank for back up (0.05% sulfur) distillate fuel oil. Emissions from the Oleander units are controlled by Dry Low NOx combustors while firing natural gas, wet injection while firing fuel oil, use of inherently clean fuels, and good combustion practices. The facility generates electricity and the SIC Code is 4911. The source category is combustion turbines.

3. List of emission units belonging to the relevant source category.


