Dear Mr. Gish:

We have reviewed your response to our latest letter requesting additional information concerning your Title V Operation Permit revision application. As indicated in that letter, the request, as structured, cannot be accomplished by revision of the Title V Operation Permit and requires submittal of an Air Construction Permit application. The emissions increases require a review for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) and a determination of Best Available Control Technology (BACT) as described in Paragraph 62-212.400, F.A.C. The required fee for permits that trigger this requirement is \$7,500.

The request can, if you wish, be processed simultaneously with the Title V Operation Permit Revision application that is hereby deemed to be incomplete, at least until the Air Construction Permit (PSD) application is submitted. You would need to update that application and include the fee, BACT proposal and PSD modeling.

Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C., requires that all applications for a Department permit must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida. This requirement also applies to responses to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. Permit applicants are advised that Rule 62-213.420(1)(b), F.A.C., requires applicants to respond to requests for information within 90 days, unless the applicant has requested in writing, and has been granted, additional time within 90 days.

As I discussed with Joe Araiza, I look forward to the opportunity to visit the facility at an early date to gain a better understanding of the present and expected plant operation. If you have any questions, please contact me at 850-921-9523 or Project Engineer Tom Cascio at 850-921-9526.
