This letter is intended to inform the Broward County Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department (the "Department") that W. R. Grace & Company-Conn., Grace Construction Products ("Grace") has agreed to sell its facility located in Pompano Beach, FL at the above address and to transfer obligations under its air permit to Specialty Vermiculite Corp., effective December 30, 2011, unless Grace notifies the agency otherwise.


