RE: Notification of a Source Subject to the Requirements Under 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart LLLLL, National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants, Asphalt Processing and Asphalt Roofing Manufacturing.

On April 29, 2003 EPA promulgated MACT standards under section 112 of the Clean Air Act for new and existing asphalt processing and asphalt roofing manufacturing facilities. 68 Fed. Reg. 22976. Section 63.8962 and Table 7 of the new regulations require the owner of every existing source subject to these regulations to give notice to the Administrator or her delegate by August 27, 2003. The contents of that notice are specified in 40 CFR 63.9(b). See 68 Fed. Reg. 23005.


While this facility's permit limitations make this standard currently applicable, Owens Corning will revise this permit and reduce potential/allowable HAPs emissions such that this facility will be rendered a synthetic minor for HAPs via a federally enforceable operating permit. This will occur before the August 29, 2006 compliance deadline.

In accordance with these provisions, I am writing to give you the required information about such a source, as follows:
