NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE PERMIT CORRECTION

Based on a request and information provided in a letter from Wheelabrator North Broward, Inc., received April 25, 2001, the Department has determined that minor corrections to information contained in FINAL Permit Number 0112120-001-AV are required. The change removes obsolete specific conditions that were deleted from the Power Plant Siting Certification for the facility on August 1, 2000. This Administrative Permit Correction was processed as project number 0112120-004-AV, pursuant to Rule 62-210.360, F.A.C. The corrections are as noted below.

- Specific Conditions **B.8.**, **B.9.**, **B.10.**, **B.41.**, **B.67.**, and **B.68.** are deleted:

B.8. Not federally enforceable. The temperature of the flue gases exiting the acid gas control equipment shall not exceed 300 degrees F.

[PA 86-22]

B.9. Not federally enforceable. The temperature of the flue gas exiting the combustion chamber of the incinerator shall be equal to or greater than 1,800 degrees F.

[PA 86-22]

B.10. Not federally enforceable. Combustion efficiency calculated by: $\% CE = \{1/[1+(CO/CO_2)]\} \times 100$ shall be at least 99.8% for an 8 hour average.

[PA 86-22]

B.41. Not federally enforceable. Stack emissions from each unit shall not exceed the following:

Volatile Organic Compound (VOC)	0.013 lb/MMBtu
Arsenic (As)	3.1×10^{-5} lb/MMBtu
Sulfuric Acid Mist (SAM)	0.047 lb/MMBtu

B.68. Not federally enforceable. Particulate testing shall include one run during representative soot blowing which shall be averaged proportionally to normal daily operations. Visible emission testing shall be conducted simultaneously with soot blowing and non-soot blowing runs.

Please find enclosed Form No. 62-210.900(1) that addresses administrative corrections to non-federally enforceable conditions in our current Title V permit.

On August 1, 2000, the facility conditions of certification for the Power Plant Siting Certification, PA 86-22 were modified by the FDEP (DEP File No. PA 86-22E). However, the revised conditions of the PPSC were not incorporated into the facility Title V permit that was issued on October 22, 2000. Since the final Title V permit conditions were based upon PPSC requirements as they existed before the August 1, 2000 PPSC modification, some Title V conditions no longer have a valid PPSC reference.

Requirements based on Title V conditions B.8. (The temperature of the flue gas exiting the acid control equipment), B.9. (The temperature of the flue gas exiting the combustion chamber) and B.10. (Combustor efficiency calculation) were removed in the PPSC modification drafts. Additionally, requirement limits and stack test methods for Volatile Organic Compounds, Arsenic and Sulfuric Acid Mist, which are listed in Title V conditions B.41 and B.67, have also been removed from the revised PPSC. Lastly, the Title V condition B.68 requirement that particulate testing be conducted during plant soot blowing operations has been removed from the revised PPSC conditions.

Based on the August 1, 2000 PPSC Final Order referenced above and the fact that the conditions are non-federally enforceable, Wheelabrator is requesting an administrative modification to the facility Title V permit for the deletion of B.8, B.9, B.41, B.67 and B.68.

Dear Mr. Roberts:

We are in receipt of your letter dated February 12, 2001 requesting an administrative correction to delete certain specific conditions from the FINAL Title V Air Operation Permit for the referenced facility. However, we must deem your application incomplete due to the following reasons:

1. Please submit your application using the proper Department form No. 62-210.900(1). The form is available on the Department's Internet web site: www.dep.state.fl.us/air. Only those pages reflecting the changes to your original Title V application need to be submitted. However, the submission needs to include the certification page with the signature of the Responsible Official of the facility.
2. Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C., requires that all original applications for a Department permit, requests for permit revision, and administrative corrections must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida. This requirement also applies to responses to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. Please ensure that the completed application is so certified.

Please also note that we are advising applicants that Rule 62-4.055(1), F.A.C., requires a response to requests for information within 90 days. When we receive the above-mentioned items, we will continue processing your application. If you have questions, please contact Tom Cascio at 850/921-9526.
