SUBJ: Preliminary Determination and Draft PSD Permit for Pompano Beach Energy Center (PSD-FL-304) located in Broward County, Florida

Dear Mr. Linero:

Thank you for sending the preliminary determination and draft prevention of significant deterioration (PSD) permit for Pompano Beach Energy Center dated March 7, 2001. The preliminary determination is for the proposed construction and operation of three simple cycle combustion turbines (CTs) with a total nominal generating capacity of 510 MW to be located near Pompano Beach, FL. The combustion turbines proposed for the facility are General Electric, frame 7 FA units. The CTs will primarily combust pipeline quality natural gas with No. 2 fuel oil combusted as backup fuel. As proposed, each CT will be allowed to fire natural gas up to 5,000 hours per year (3,500 hours per year average) and fire No. 2 fuel oil a maximum of 1,000 hours per year. Total net emissions increases from the proposed project are above the thresholds requiring PSD review for nitrogen oxides (NO_x), carbon monoxide (CO), sulfur dioxide (SO₂), and particulate matter (PM/PM₁₀).

Based on our review of the PSD permit application, preliminary determination and draft PSD permit, we have the following comments:

1. The PSD permit application indicates (page 1-1 and 2-1) that "natural gas be the primary fuel source and oil will be used only to the extent transmission capacity constraints on Florida Gas Transmission preclude the delivery of natural gas to the site." We recommend that the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) consider including language in the final PSD permit to restrict the applicant's use of fuel oil to only those times natural gas cannot be delivered to the Pompano Beach Energy Center.
2. In Section III, condition 29d of the draft PSD permit, excess emissions during startup and shutdown are allowed for up to 2 hours in any 24-hour period. Because periods of startup and shutdown are part of normal source operation, we recommend that FDEP also consider establishment of startup and shutdown best available control technology (BACT) emission limits for CO and NO_x such as mass emission limits (for example, pounds of emissions in any 24-hour period) that include startup and shutdown emissions, or future emission limits

derived from monitoring results during the first few months of commercial operation. We further recommend that FDEP include definitions of what constitutes periods of startup and shutdown as referenced in Condition 29d.

3. Section III, condition 10 of the draft PSD permit limits each individual CT to operating a maximum of 5,000 hours per year and all the CTs to an average of 3,500 hours per year per CT. Since it is possible for any single CT to operate up to 5,000 hours per year, the BACT analyses (which are currently based on 3,500 hours per year) should be reconsidered to take this limit into account. In order for the current BACT analyses to remain valid, the final PSD permit should restrict the operation of each individual CT to a maximum of 3,500 hours per year.
4. Table 5-5 (catalytic oxidation) and Table C-2 (high temperature selective catalytic reduction) include a figure which accounts for the "Cost of Heat Rate Loss," based on an estimated market value of \$0.10/kW-hr. Although it is appropriate to calculate the cost of using additional natural gas to compensate for the power consumption resulting from pressure drops across the catalyst bed, lost revenue should not be included in the cost analyses.

Dear Mr. Linero,

I am very concerned that the Florida Department of Environmental Protection is considering issuing a Final Air Construction Permit to the Enron Corporation for the Pompano Beach power plant facility. After reviewing the Draft Permit Application and supporting documents I feel the FDEP should not author the Final Permit under any circumstances based on the following information.

First, as a Aquatic Ecologist I am accustomed to working with and reviewing modeling techniques. I understand first handedly that modeling the rapid onset torrential rainfall events typical of South Florida's subtropical climate is particularly difficult. This leads me to question the ability of the models used to accurately estimate the quantity of pollutants deposited in the local environment. I am particularly concerned with the quantity of nitrogen oxides (NO_x) and sulfur dioxides (SO₂) that will be deposited during summertime rainfall events when the power plant will operate at its peak output capacity to meet the demands of summertime air conditioning in Broward County. The sulfur dioxide and nitrogen oxides will impair the respiratory function of our children, our elderly, while simultaneously pollute the waters of South Florida.

Secondly, as a professional Water Quality Manger I will attest to the poor quality of many South Florida water bodies. Many waters that are supposed to be deemed fishable and swimable by Florida Water Quality Standards are contaminated with mercury. The problems associated with mercury contamination are greatest in the Central Everglades portion of Broward County where the Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission advises that no humans should consume bass caught from these areas. Although, I understand that mercury emissions associated with the operation of this power plant are minimal, the operation of this power plant will undoubtedly increase the concentration of methymercury in the environment. Mercury is an elemental metal that undergoes a chemical transformation called methylation before it can be accumulated in the flesh of fish and animals. Once incorporated into the food web methylmercury poisons top predators like bass, birds of prey, mammals, and humans. Scientists have determined that sulfur pollution greatly increases the concentration of mercury's methylated toxic form in aquatic environments. I feel any increase in sulfur pollution can not be tolerated by South Florida's sensitive aquatic environment and should not be tolerated by its public or the Department of Environmental Protection.

In closing, the impact of the Enron Power plant will have a synergistic effect. The American Heritage Dictionary defines synergy as an "interaction of two or more agents or forces so that their combined effect is greater than the sum of their individual effects". That is, I expect the combined pollution emissions and environmental impacts will be much greater than the permit suggests. I feel, when faced with providing power for the rapidly growing South Florida community the Florida Department of Environmental Protection will approve future permit revisions that will enable the Enron power plant to operate for many more hours than originally proposed. Not if, but when this happens the pollution loads distributed to Broward County and the Greater Everglades ecosystem will more than double as the hours of operation increase and the efficiency of pollution reduction mechanisms decrease

With this information, and the public outcry over the construction of the Enron facility I hope, and urge the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to make "a different decision" and impress the South Florida community with its ability and commitment to protecting the environment and the Greater Everglades ecosystem.

Comments To Florida Department Of Environmental Protection

One of the first impressions anyone has when initially arriving in our beautiful area is how clean the air is compared to their hometown and other places they've visited. There was a time when New York, Chicago, Los Angeles and Houston also had clean air. Those cities and far too many others now suffer with poor air quality caused by excessive pollution, at the very least some of which is created by the emission in the atmosphere of **diesel fuel** and other pollutants.

To allow the construction of **80 foot high smoke stacks**, along with "natural gas and distillate fuel oil-fired combustion turbine-electrical generators" to be built in the heart of our beautiful environment is unconscionable and would be nothing less than unforgivable.

The sites proposed for these facilities are within walking distance from a major tourist attraction and a beautiful county park heavily frequented by families with children and populated by wildlife, horses and a petting zoo. The winds that blow through this area carry our air and everything in it to the nearby Florida Everglades, passing over tens of thousands of homes and dozens of schools along the way.

Anyone who cares about our environment, the whitewashed description of this proposed project notwithstanding, must stand up and say No Way. Absolutely Not.

Oh sure, spin doctors and PR experts, like modern day snake oil salesmen, can make anything sound acceptable or even good. But you don't need a study or a degree in rocket science to know in your gut and in your heart that what is being proposed here is absolutely unacceptable.

The Everglades is a precious natural resource and our children even more so. For these reasons alone, this project should not be permitted. But there's more.

Enron would have to spend hundreds of millions of dollars to complete this assault on our environment. It doesn't take an MBA to understand that they would not make such an investment, and make no mistake, to them it is an investment, without believing and planning to recoup every dollar they spend and hundreds of millions more in profit. Ask yourselves a simple question. Who are they going to derive that profit from? 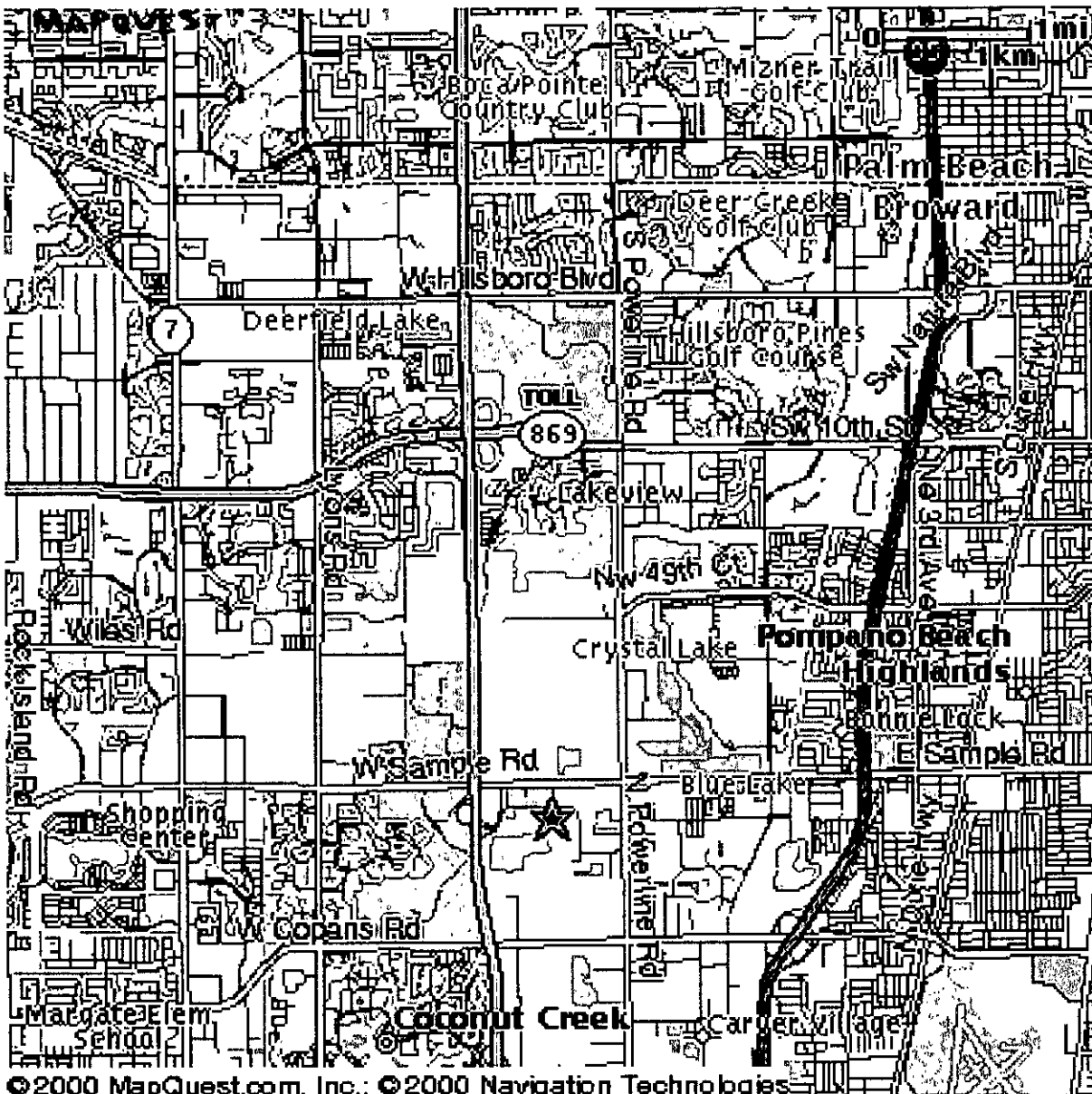

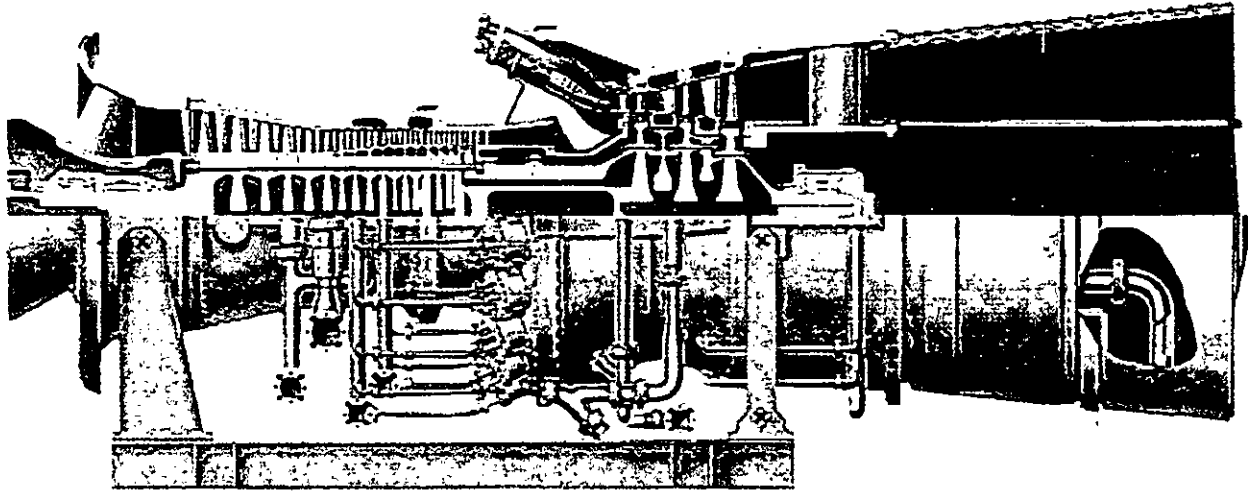

Pompano Beach Energy L.L.C. (an affiliate of Enron North America) submitted an application to construct three 170-megawatt (MW) combustion turbine electrical generators and ancillary equipment in Pompano Beach, Broward County. The location is East of the Turnpike and South of Sample Road as shown in the following map.

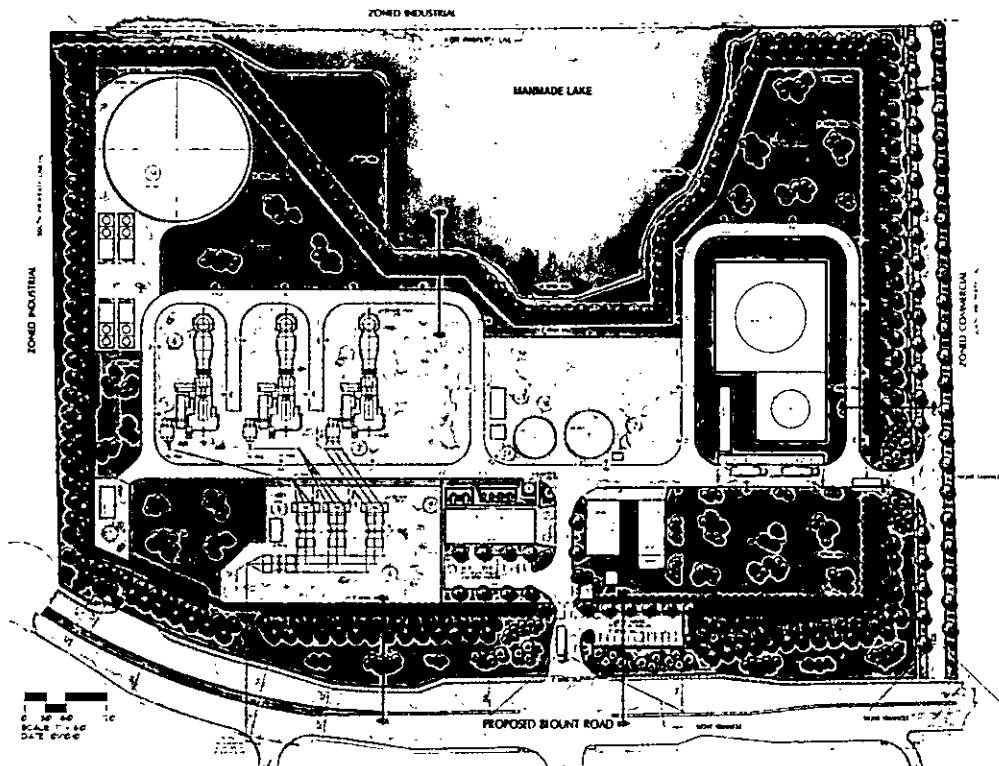


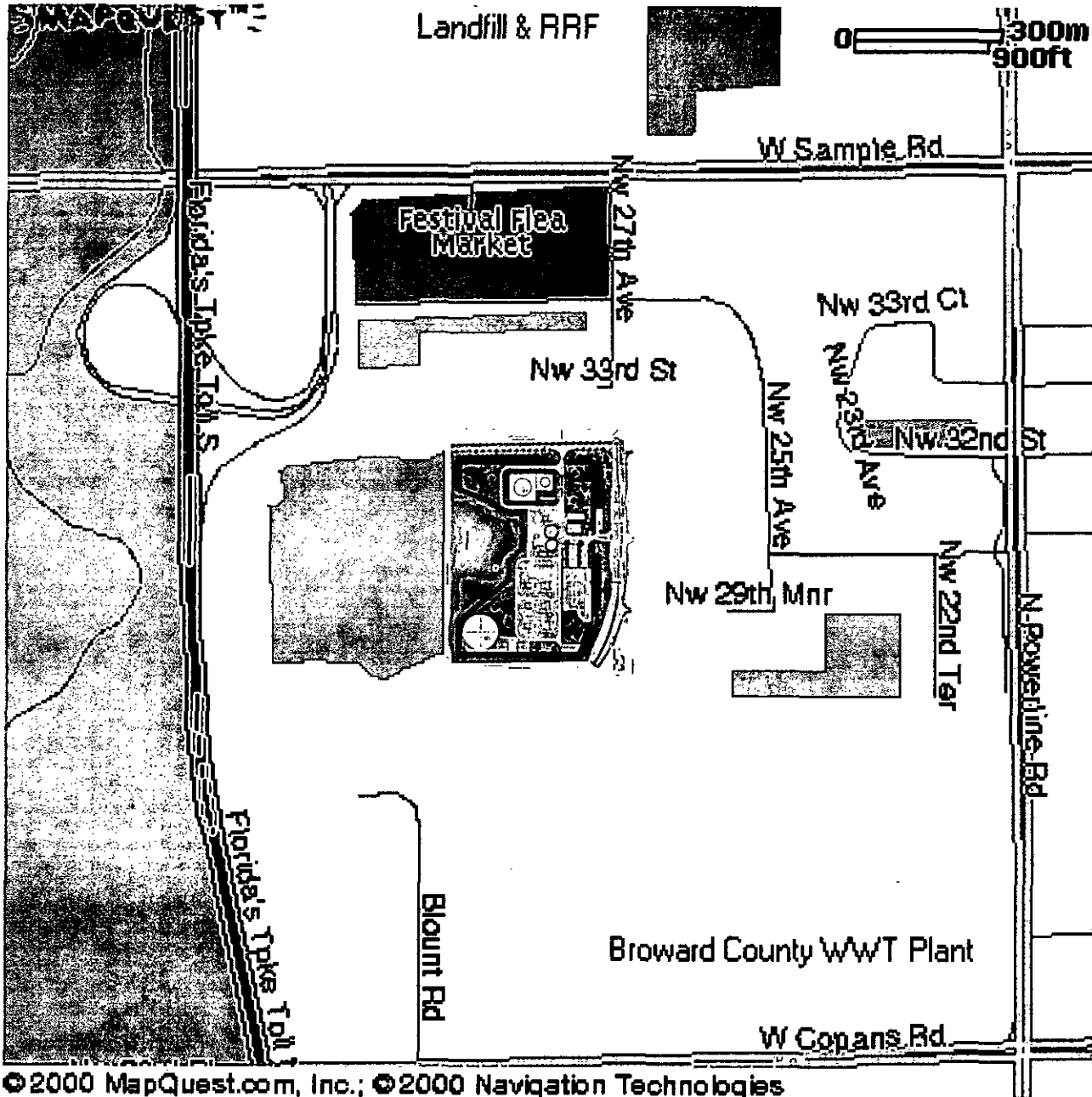
Each unit is a General Electric 7FA gas-fired combustion turbine, which directly generates approximately 170 MW of electricity. The units will operate in simple cycle and intermittent duty. There will not be separate heat recovery steam generators and steam-driven electrical generators. The project includes three 80-foot stacks, a 2.5 million-gallon storage tank for back-up diesel fuel, a 0.6 million gallon day tank, four mechanical draft cooling towers, and a 13-million Btu per hour gas heater. Following is a picture of a GE 7FA.



Basically these units are like jet engines. Air is drawn in and compressed. Fuel is introduced in the combustors. Hot exhaust gases expand in the rotor section. The rotational motion of the shaft drives the compressor and the electrical generator normally located before the compressor section.

Following is an artist's rendition of the layout for the facility and an overlay of the plant on the proposed site.

We do not have an elevated artist's rendition of the site. Following is a picture borrowed from a similar project in Brevard County (reference Oleander website www.oleanderpower.com)



The key air emissions will consist of nitrogen oxides, carbon monoxide, particulate matter, and sulfur dioxide. Air pollution control will be accomplished through "Dry-Low NO_x combustion" and use of natural gas with low sulfur diesel oil as backup. Pompano Beach Energy requested only 3,500 hours per year of operation. That is roughly 40 percent of the time in a year. Actual hours of operation are likely to be lower.

The facility will use very low sulfur No. 2 distillate fuel oil as back-up fuel for up to 1000 hours per year per unit. For every hour of operation on fuel oil (beyond 250 hours per year per unit) the authorized hours of operation will be reduced by two hours per year per unit. This will encourage use of natural gas. For example, if the facility uses fuel oil during 1000 hours per year per unit, it may only operate a total of 2000 hours per year per unit (instead of 3500 hours per year per unit).

Most conventional oil-fired power plants in South Florida burn residual fuel oil with a sulfur content of 1 to 2.5 percent. The sulfur content of the No. 2 distillate fuel oil is 0.05 percent and produces very little ash. There will be virtually no visible plume (0 to 10 percent opacity) from the proposed facility, whereas the typical opacity of existing conventional residual oil-fired plants in Southeast Florida is approximately 20 percent and they are allowed up to 40 percent opacity under normal operations.

The Department has determined that the ambient air impacts of the facility are very low and will not cause or contribute to a violation of any of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards and Increments.

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is the permitting authority for the air construction permit under Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes, Chapters 62-4, 62-210 and 62-212 of the Florida Administrative Code.

The DEP Bureau of Air Regulation in Tallahassee received the application on October 23, 2000. We distributed it to the EPA Region 4 office in Atlanta, the U.S. National Park Service's Air Resources Division in Denver, Colorado, and the Broward County Department of Planning and Environmental Protection.

The Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination and the draft air permit were completed and sent to the applicant on March 7 along with the Department's Intent to Issue. Copies were provided to the previously - mentioned agencies, the mayors of the nearby cities and the County Commissioners representing the nearby Districts. Copies were made available for public inspection at DEP offices in Tallahassee and West Palm Beach and the Broward County Department of Planning and Environmental Protection. The Department's Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit was published by the applicant in the Fort Lauderdale Sun-Sentinel on March 10. It provided a 30-day period for anyone to submit comments on the Department's proposed action. It also provided a 14-day period for anyone whose substantial interests are affected by the project to file a petition for an administrative hearing. Thus far, a number of cities have asked for additional time to consider filing petitions.

The Public Notice of Intent to Issue published on March 10 and a notice in the Florida Administrative Weekly of March 16 advised of this meeting.

As I mentioned before, you can view the entire package on our website. We will be happy to e-mail to you along with any presentation materials from this meeting. You can also call if you want us to guide you through our Internet Site so you can retrieve this material. The application and complete permitting file are also available for public review and copying at our offices in Tallahassee and West Palm Beach and the Broward County Department of Planning and Environmental Protection in Fort Lauderdale.

Issues such as zoning are beyond the scope of our authority in making this permitting decision. These fall within local ordinances and local planning and zoning authorities. An air construction permit does not authorize any infringement of federal, state, or local laws or regulations. Also such a permit is not a waiver or approval of any other Department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in the permit.

DEP will consider comments specifically related to air emissions and control, which are submitted here and until April 10. These comments will be reviewed prior to issuance of the final permit decision. We do not expect that to occur before the end of April. If an administrative hearing is held, we must generally abide by the findings of fact and the recommended order from the administrative law judge when issuing a final order.

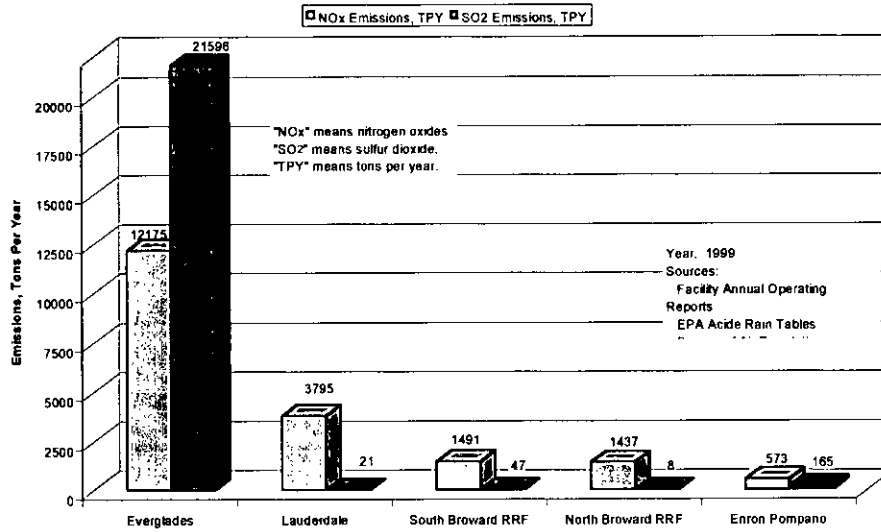

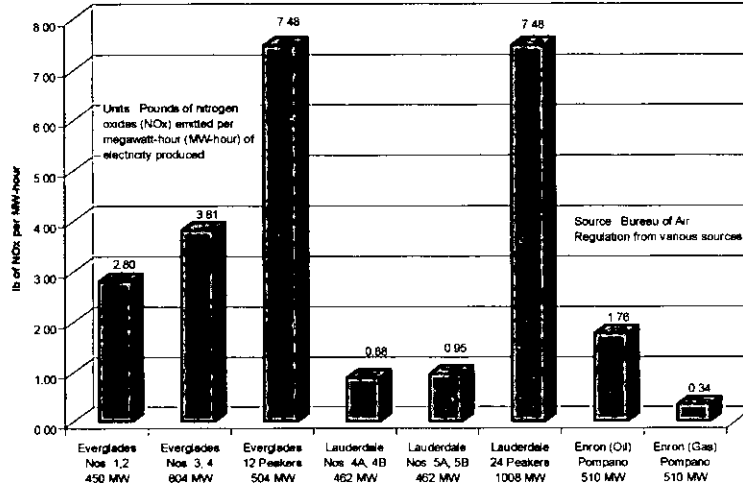

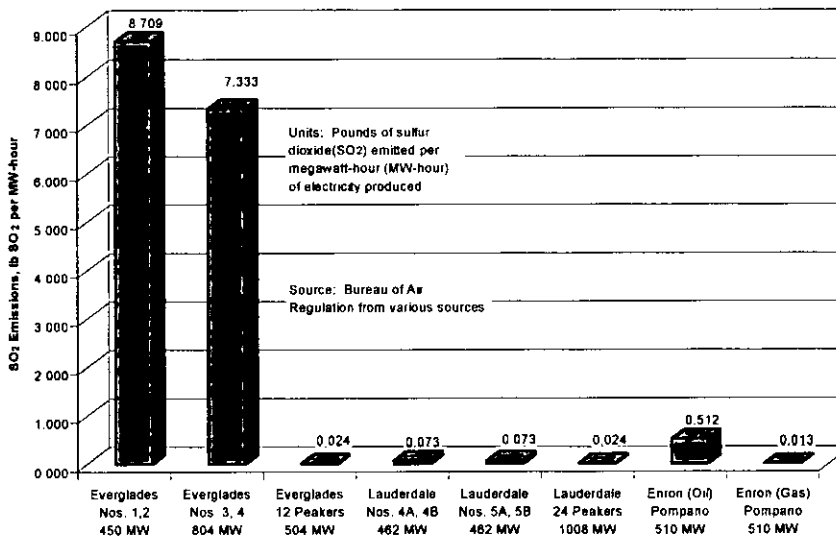
Comparison of 1999 Emissions from Power Plants in Broward County with Potential Emissions from Proposed Enron Pompano Project



NOx Emissions per Unit of Electricity Produced from Power Plants in Broward County and Enron Pompano Project

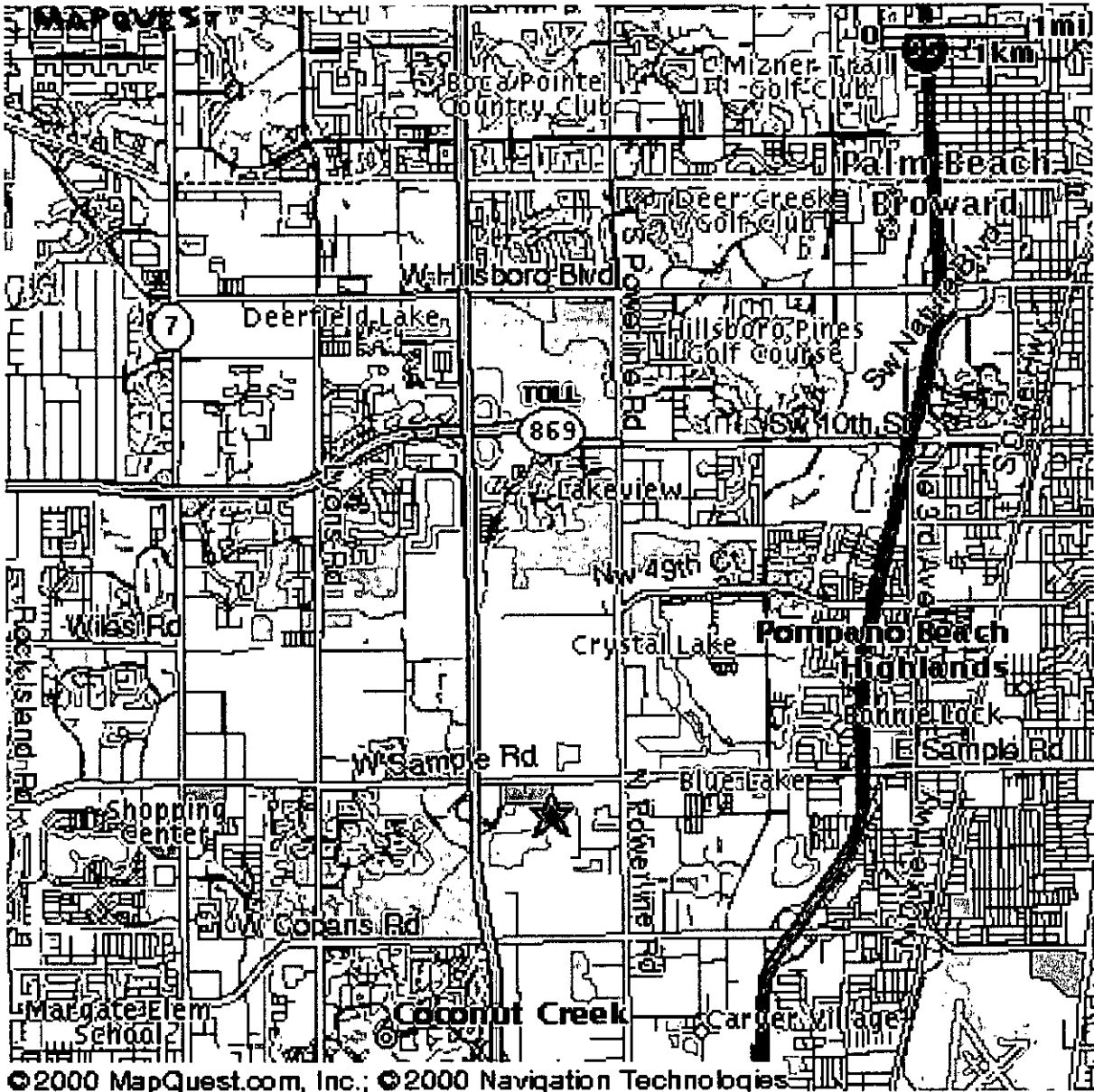


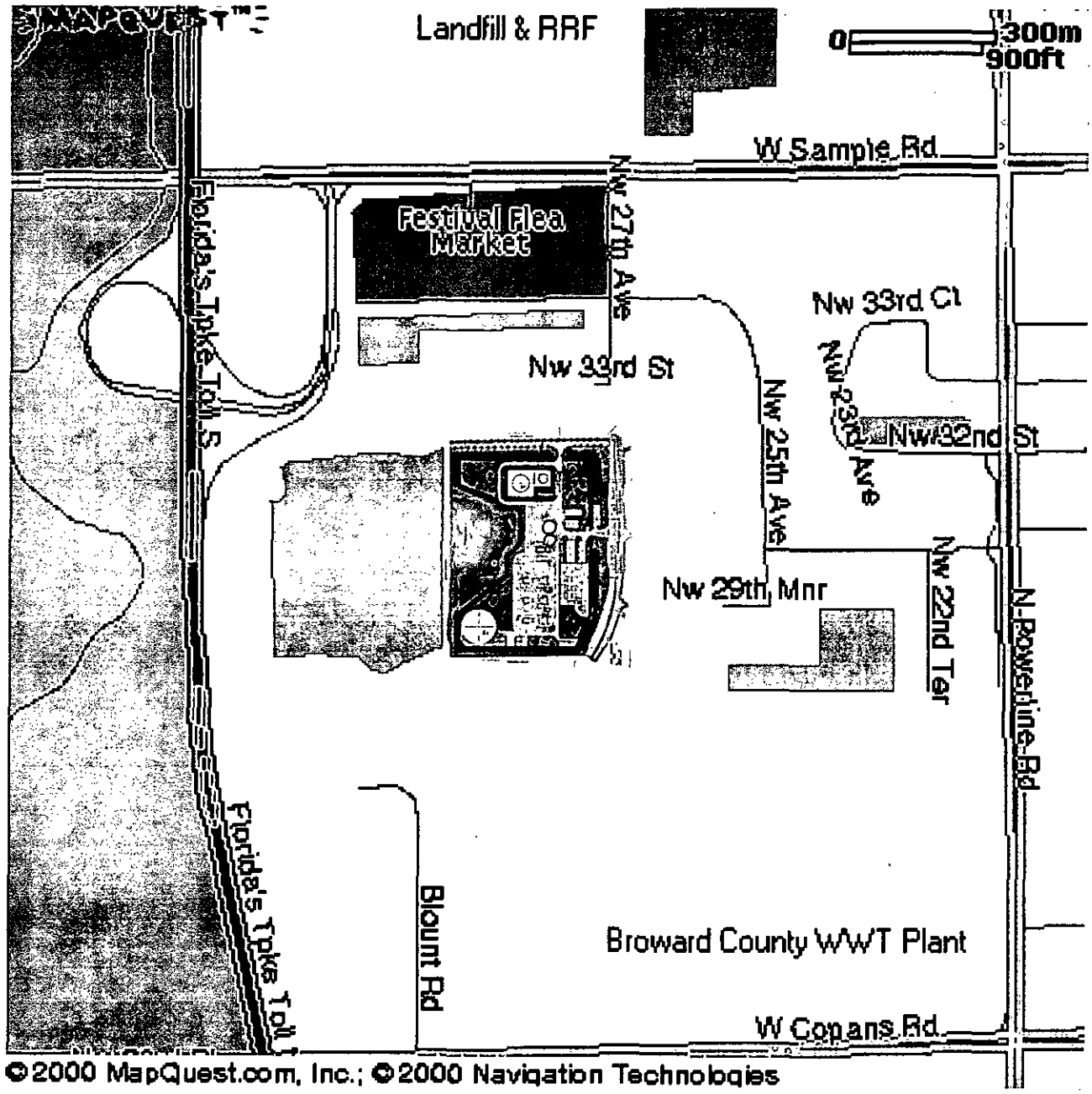
SO2 Emissions per Unit of Electricity Produced from Power Plants in Broward County and Enron Pompano Project



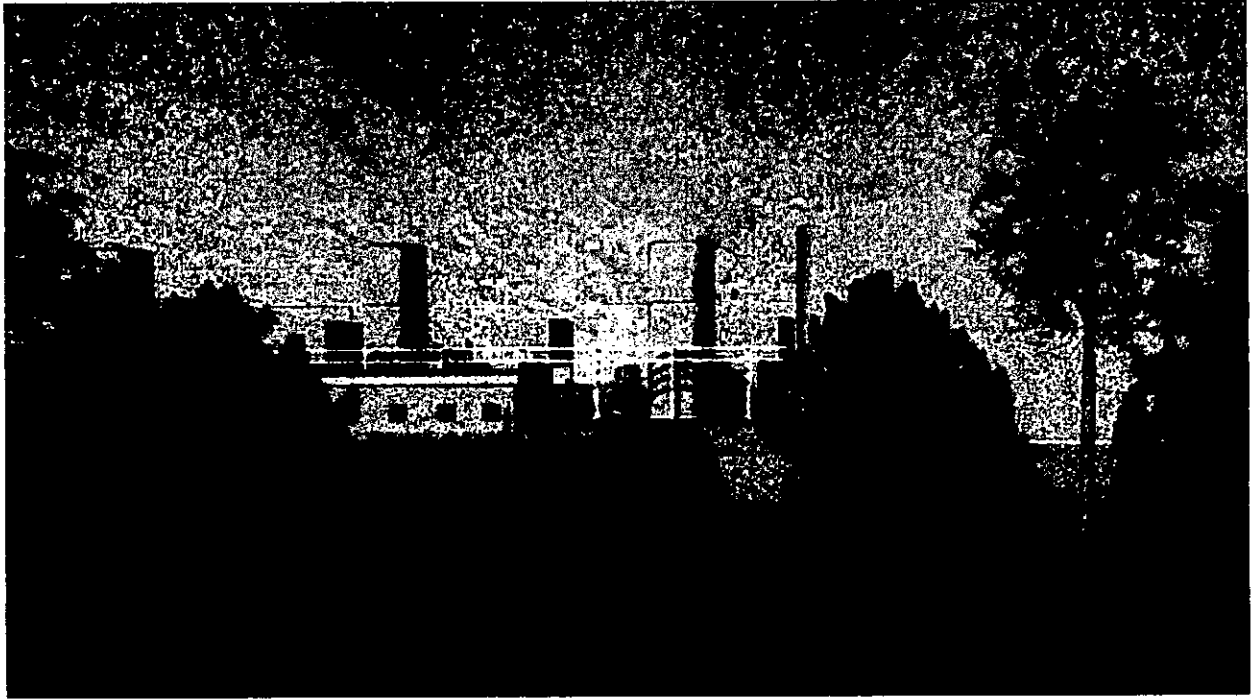

THREE 170 MEGAWATT GAS -FIRED COMBUSTION TURBINE
PUBLIC MEETING – POMPANO BEACH, BROWARD COUNTY
MARCH 26, 2001

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The facility will use very low sulfur No. 2 distillate fuel oil as back-up fuel for up to 1000 hours per year per unit. For every hour of operation on fuel oil (beyond 250 hours per year per unit) the authorized hours of operation will be reduced by two hours per year per unit. This will encourage use of natural gas. For example, if the facility uses fuel oil during 1000 hours per year per unit, it may only operate a total of 2000 hours per year per unit (instead of 3500 hours per year per unit).

Most conventional oil-fired power plants in South Florida burn residual fuel oil with a sulfur content of 1 to 2.5 percent. The sulfur content of the No. 2 distillate fuel oil is 0.05 percent and produces very little ash. There will be virtually no visible plume (0 to 10 percent opacity) from the proposed facility, whereas the typical opacity of existing conventional residual oil-fired plants in Southeast Florida is approximately 20 percent and they are allowed up to 40 percent opacity under normal operations.

The Department has determined that the ambient air impacts of the facility are very low and will not cause or contribute to a violation of any of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards and Increments.

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The DEP Bureau of Air Regulation in Tallahassee received the application on October 23, 2000. We distributed it to the EPA Region 4 office in Atlanta, the U.S. National Park Service's Air Resources Division in Denver, Colorado, and the Broward County Department of Planning and Environmental Protection.

The Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination and the draft air permit were completed and sent to the applicant on March 7 along with the Department's Intent to Issue. Copies were provided to the previously - mentioned agencies, the mayors of the nearby cities and the County Commissioners representing the nearby Districts. Copies were made available for public inspection at DEP offices in Tallahassee and West Palm Beach and the Broward County Department of Planning and Environmental Protection. The Department's Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit was published by the applicant in the Fort Lauderdale Sun-Sentinel on March 10. It provided a 30-day period for anyone to submit comments on the Department's proposed action. It also provided a 14-day period for anyone whose substantial interests are affected by the project to file a petition for an administrative hearing. Thus far, a number of cities have asked for additional time to consider filing petitions.

The Public Notice of Intent to Issue published on March 10 and a notice in the Florida Administrative Weekly of March 16 advised of this meeting.

As I mentioned before, you can view the entire package on our website. We will be happy to e-mail to you along with any presentation materials from this meeting. You can also call if you want us to guide you through our Internet Site so you can retrieve this material. The application and complete permitting file are also available for public review and copying at our offices in Tallahassee and West Palm Beach and the Broward County Department of Planning and Environmental Protection in Fort Lauderdale.

Issues such as zoning are beyond the scope of our authority in making this permitting decision. These fall within local ordinances and local planning and zoning authorities. An air construction permit does not authorize any infringement of federal, state, or local laws or regulations. Also such a permit is not a waiver or approval of any other Department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in the permit.

DEP will consider comments specifically related to air emissions and control, which are submitted here and until April 10. These comments will be reviewed prior to issuance of the final permit decision. We do not expect that to occur before the end of April. If an administrative hearing is held, we must generally abide by the findings of fact and the recommended order from the administrative law judge when issuing a final order.

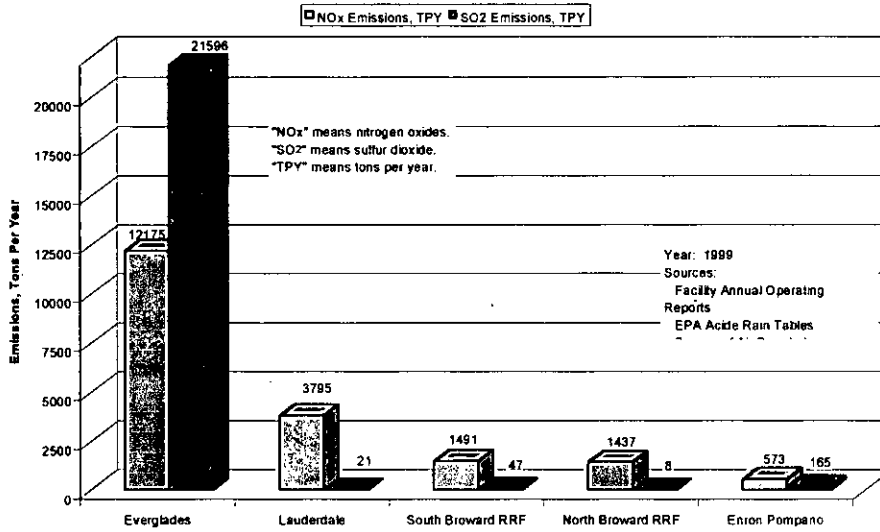

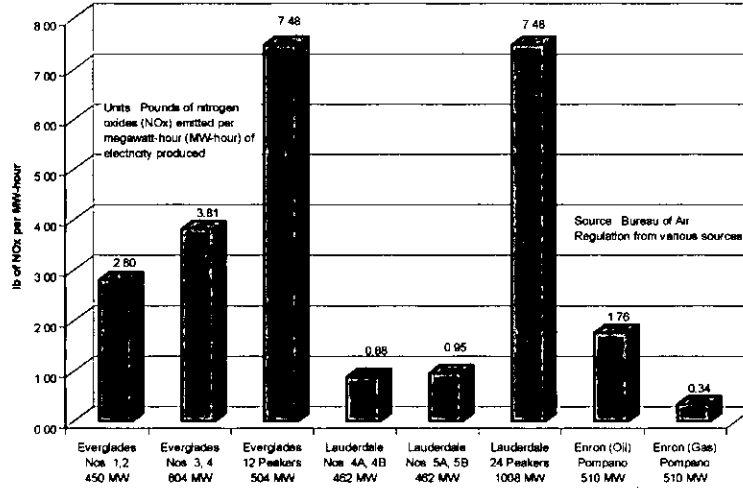

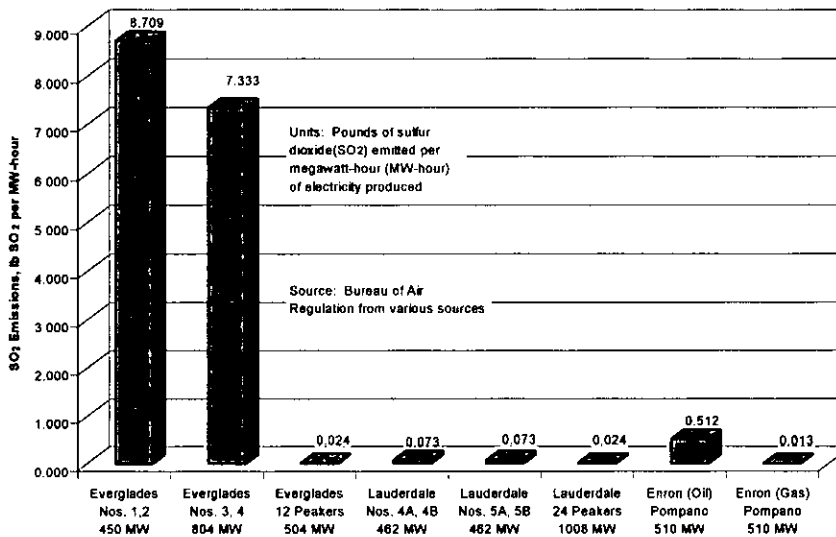
**Comparison of 1999 Emissions from Power Plants in Broward County

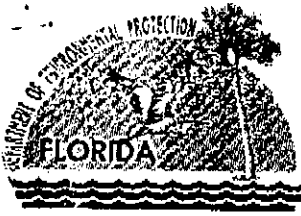

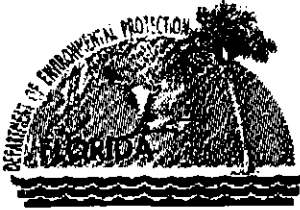

In response to your five questions received on March 7 via fax, your questions will be restated followed by an appropriate response.

(1) Having some plants only using natural gas, why is diesel in Pompano-Deerfield?

Diesel at a maximum sulfur content of 0.05 percent is being proposed to be used at the Pompano Beach Energy Center as a secondary fuel. The primary fuel to be used is natural. The turbines are limited to 3500 hours averaged per year per unit. Moreover, should the facility operate on diesel for more than 250 hours, then the maximum hours that the turbines can operate is reduce by two for every beyond 250 hours. For example, since each turbine is limited to 1000 hours on diesel, then the maximum hours that each could operate is 2000 hours (i.e., $3500 - [(1000 - 250) \times 2] = 2000$). In essence, the facility is being forced to use natural gas rather than diesel. Please see Technical Evaluation at page TE-4.

(2) What basis of what potential shortages or emergency exists to expedite plants this quickly?

This is an excellent question; however, since it is not a permitting question a definitive answer cannot be provided by the department. It is being recommended that you contact Mr. Walter L. Revell, Chairman of the Florida Energy 2020 Study Commission. His address is Knott Building, Room 225 B Tallahassee, Florida 32399-000. It is also being recommended that you read Mr. Revell's proposal for restructuring Florida's wholesale market for electricity. The website address is http://www.myflorida.com/myflorida/government/learn/energy_commission/commissionReports.html

(3) Why not use of electrostatic reciprocators?

First of all, it appears that you intended to ask about electrostatic precipitators. Electrostatic precipitators are pollution control devices used to control the emission of particulate matter (PM). In this particular project, PM is a concern based on its potential emission of 41 tons per year (TPY). Because it is greater than the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) significance level of 25 TPY, PSD review was required and a Best Available Control Technology (BACT) determination was also required. Electrostatic precipitators did not come out in the analysis as BACT. BACT was determined to be good combustion of clean natural gas and the limited use of low sulfur (0.05 percent) diesel fuel oil. Please see Technical Evaluation at page TE-6. Also, keep in mind that most conventional oil-fired power plants in South Florida burn residual oil with a sulfur content of 1 to 2.5 percent.

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(4) Where are performance-based standards?

The Department is in the process of addressing performance-based standards for future permitting. This is a subject matter that is currently before the Florida Legislature. Secretary Strubs, strongly supports performance-based permitting.

(5) Dispersion Model?

Modeling is required in PSD review and was done for this project. Please see Technical Evaluation at pages TE-7-12. If you have questions regarding the modeling, please contact Cleve Holladay in Tallahassee at 850/488-1344.

Enron Corp. a powerful opponent

Presidential ties,
past problems
raise concerns

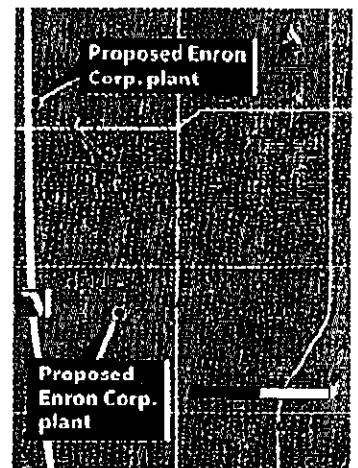
As they fight Enron Corp.'s plans for two power plants near their homes, residents of northern Broward County are taking on one of the largest and best-connected companies in the United States.

The Houston energy conglomerate operates power plants, electricity trading operations and natural gas pipelines all over the world. Its chairman is a close friend of President Bush. Enron has won praise from environmental groups for embracing alternative energy, such as wind-powered turbines. And it has been criticized for fighting pollution restrictions in Texas and employing security guards who beat protesters of a power plant in India.

In Broward County, Enron has proposed the construction of two 510-megawatt power plants along Florida's Turnpike in Pompano Beach and Deerfield Beach.

New power sources

Enron Corp. and Coastal Corp. want to build three power plants in northern Broward County.

As neighborhoods organized to fight the projects, word of Enron's wealth and influence has spread.

"They are a very formidable opponent," said Claire Hornstein,

who lives in the Palau Aire neighborhood, a block two miles south of the Pompano Beach site. "But more formidable are the people. We have the numbers, and we cannot allow elected officials to betray us, to sell us down the river. The health of the community is involved. Let's hope a couple of commissioners are strong enough to resist the formidable power of a global corporation."

The company has gained attention recently for its close ties to the president. Enron and its executives gave \$72,000 to Bush over the years, making the company history's single donor, according to the Center for Public Integrity, a nonpartisan group that tracks money in politics.

Enron Chairman Kenneth Lay personally contributed \$275,000 to the Republican National Committee during the recent election and gave \$5,000 to the fund that financed the successful legal fight for Florida's electoral votes. He was among the business leaders who participated in an economics summit that Bush called just before taking office.

"Ken Lay has an extremely close relationship with Bush," said Steven Weiss, communications director for the Center for Responsive Politics, a nonprofit group that tracks campaign money. "He has contributed substantial amounts to Bush's campaigns for governor and president. He was a member of one of Bush's advisory transition teams, and he is known to have Bush's ear on sensitive issues."

Enron spokesman Eric Thode said Weiss' group and others like it have exaggerated the company's ties to the Republicans.

"They are buying in on one instance, the presidential race of 2000," he said. "If you looked across the board, federal and state, it's split 50-50, Democrat and Republican. You find plenty of executives that gave money to Al Gore, and they're not employed by Enron."

Of the company's chairman, Thode said, "It's hard to fault a per-

son for supporting someone they've been friends with for 30 years. Dr. Lay has known the Bush family since the 1970s. They're family friends. You expect friends to support friends."

The company, which reported a net income of \$1.3 billion last year, has a mixed environmental record. It has won praise from environmental groups for its investments in renewable energy, having built the world's largest wind power complex in Iowa. As a major supplier of natural gas, it provides a source of energy that is far cleaner than oil or coal.

It broke with other energy companies to join a business coalition to address global warming, winning praise as a "progressive company" from the Natural Resources Defense Council. And Lay appeared on the environmental radio show Living on Earth, in which he said, "Most responsible business leaders today understand that the environment is a very, very critical part of how we do business, how we must do business."

But Enron has caught its share of criticism on environmental issues: When villagers in Dabhol, India, protested a \$2.5 billion power plant project, they were repeatedly arrested and beaten by police and security guards on Enron's payroll, according to a 1999 report by Hu-

man Rights Watch.

"Enron's local entity, the Dabhol Power Corporation, benefited directly from an official policy of suppressing dissent through misuse of the law, harassment of anti-Enron protest leaders and prominent environmental activists, and police practices ranging from arbitrary to brutal," the report states. "The company did not speak out about human rights violations, and, when questioned about them, chose to discuss them altogether."

Enron spokesman Thode acknowledged problems in India but said company executives replaced the security guards who engaged in violence.

"Certainly there were some problems," he said. "But when it became known, it was dealt with." Enron was also among a group of Texas companies that successfully lobbied to prevent a crackdown on old power plants, refineries and other operations that were built before the Clean Air Act of 1971, according to a report by Texans for Public Justice, nonprofit research group. After contributing millions of dollars and working the Legislature, the groups achieved its aim of a program based on voluntary restrictions, the report says.

Enron was part of the group that got Gov. Bush to designate a toothless program to close the grandfa-

ther loophole," said Craig McDonnell, the group's executive director. "It was all public relations, and it resulted in virtually no improvement in air quality."

Enron disputes this interpretation. Forming the plants to meet current standards would have driven many out of business, costing thousands of jobs, said Thode, the company spokesman.

The company has used its clout to push for deregulation of the electric industry, which would offer opportunities for the sort of electricity trading in which it specializes. Enron successfully pushed for deregulation in Texas and hopes to do the same in Florida.

"The goal is to have everything deregulated so everyone is swapping power back and forth," said Barry Moline, executive director of the Florida Municipal Electric Association, which represents local utilities. "With regulated plants you have fewer transactions. Their ultimate goal is to have every power plant in the country deregulated. They see themselves as the dealmaker, putting together producers and buyers."

In the past two years, as Florida legislators have begun to consider deregulation, Enron has contributed \$158,250 to the state's politicians.

It is unclear how the company's proposed plants in Broward Coun-

ty would fit into their plans. Enron insists the two proposed plants would function only as "peaker" plants, operating less than 10 hours a day on average and going into service only when a utility faced a shortfall of electricity.

But if deregulation came to Florida, some say the company would attempt to operate the plants 24 hours a day and sell power to anyone it could. The company may be tempted to increase the plants' output by converting them to combined-cycle plants, in which they would add a generator that would be powered by exhaust from the primary generators, Moline said.

"If merchant plants are allowed in Florida, they'll add a component to the plant to increase its efficiency and lower its costs," he said. "Once you've paid for the system, you don't want it to just sit there. If it were a combined-cycle plant, they could sell to any utility that needed power."

Company officials insist they have no such plans. They say the deregulation debate has no bearing on the two plants in Broward. They said it would simply be too difficult to convert, both from an engineering and a regulatory perspective.

"Different equipment, different permit," Thode said. "You may as well build a new facility. The plant is a peaker plant, and it will always be a peaker plant."

The Pompano Beach project has moved more quickly than the one in Deerfield Beach. The state Department of Environmental Protection last week announced its intention to grant the company a construction permit for the Pompano Beach project, although it has not yet made a final decision.

The big fight now is before the Pompano Beach City Commission, which must decide whether to rezone the land to allow Enron to proceed with its plans.

Fearing pollution, many residents of Deerfield Beach, Pompano Beach and other cities are organizing to fight the projects.

In the Inland Empire Bay section of Deerfield Beach, the city association plans to charter buses to bring protesters to a March 26 public meeting on the Pompano Beach project by the state Department of Environmental Protection. While they may not be able to stop the plant, they stand a chance of forcing Enron to modify its plans by using less diesel fuel, said Sybil Melone, the association's president.

"When you get the people outraged, just like we had with the ash barge, maybe someone will take notice," he said.

Enclosed are 3 revised pages replacing pages of the Public Notice and the Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination, for the Pompano Beach Energy Center draft permit package. We found that for some pollutants (NO_x, SO₂, and sulfuric acid mist), the highest emissions occur when operating 1000 hours on natural gas and 1000 hours on fuel oil. For other pollutants (PM₁₀, VOC, and CO), the highest emissions occur when operating 3250 hours on natural gas and 250 hours on fuel oil. Please replace the respective pages in the package dated March 7, 2001.

We advised Mr. Dave Kellermeyer of this matter on March 8. He informed me that the Notice of Intent to Issue Air construction permit will be published with the corrected values. Corrections were made on March 8 in these same documents available on our website.
