I am writing to you to express my deepest concerns and disapproval regarding the proposed building of two power plants in South Florida - one in Deerfield Beach and the other in neighboring Pompano Beach.

Sir, I recognize the fact that South Florida, and the entire state, is growing in population. And this is part of my point: to place not one, but two, power plants so close to residential neighborhoods is reckless in terms of the health risks and decline in property values that would surely occur.

Effectively these two power plants would be only about 2 miles from each other, sending plenty of pollution into the air at a higher concentration than one plant would. As much as I recognize the need for additional power plants, the proposed location – in the middle of business and residential neighborhoods – is completely wrong; they should be moved to open land west of the Florida Turnpike where residential development has yet to be started.

Sample Road, a major thoroughfare that has been under construction for the past 2 years to add one lane in each direction, would only incur more traffic as each plant is on either side of this road. In addition, the added traffic would be trucks from and to each plant; the potential of a higher number of more lethal accidents is evident. The increased traffic would wipe out the benefits of the road construction we have been putting up with for the past 2 years.

As an asthma sufferer, I can only expect my condition to get worse as time goes by with the pollutants that these power plants will produce. As a new homeowner (May 1999) I expect my property value to decrease if these plants are built. I live in a fine neighborhood with many nice families and their children. As a former homeowner's association board member who knows many of his neighbors, I can truthfully state that anyone I have talked to in my neighborhood of Eastridge is opposed to the building of these power plants so close to us.

Please sir, do not let our quality of life suffer by allowing these power plants to be built within our neighborhoods. Please vote not to issue Enron the permits to build in our backyards.

Thank you for your recent letter regarding perpetual motion and your question regarding new power plant capacity in Florida. I apologize that it took me this long to respond, but your first issue is not an easy one to address.

I don't believe that development of perpetual motion will solve any problems soon. Unfortunately the laws of thermodynamics do not permit machines that operate on this principle while delivering energy for work. Until those laws get changed (which is very doubtful) we will need to rely on the conventional machines that we are already familiar with.

I do support continued research into improving the efficiency of existing technology. For example, the Department of Energy (DOE) and manufacturers of gas turbines spent a great deal of money to promote improvement of energy efficiency. Over the past 30 years, the so-called simple cycle gas turbines have improved from around 25 percent to almost 40 percent in converting the chemical energy to rotational and then to electrical energy. The combined cycle plants have improved from about 40 percent to almost 60 percent. This has occurred with very substantial reductions in emissions.

DOE is also promoting "renewable energy" such as wind, geothermal, and solar energy that may seem to operate much like perpetual motion but do satisfy the laws of thermodynamics. Hydroelectric energy is another form that unfortunately has been largely tapped out. Unfortunately they cannot supply anywhere near the energy needs of the country.

You stated that FP&L plans to build 11,000 megawatts of capacity over the next ten years. Perhaps you mean all regulated utilities combined will build that much capacity. That would include Tampa Electric, Florida Power Corporation, various municipally owned utilities, etc.

Our preliminary decisions regarding Enron's proposed projects were based on adherence to air regulations. We have issued draft permits for public comments. Petitions have been filed for administrative hearings for both of these projects.

In answer to your second issue, I don't have an opinion on what entities are the more logical ones to build power plants. It is a matter of much debate and not one that is within the scope of our review for air construction permit applications.

I thank you again for taking the time to write and express your opinion. Feel free to call me at 850/921-9523 if you want to discuss these matters at greater length.

#### George W. Bush Gets Layed

The Mutually Beneficial Relationship Between Enron CEO Ken Lay and the Republican Contender

Early last October, every member of a ninth grade girls track team and the freshman football team at suburban Houston's Deer Park High School's north campus returned from practice reporting severe breathing problems. That day Deer Park registered 251 parts of ozone per billion, more than twice the federal standard, and Houston surpassed Los Angeles as the smoggiest city in the United States.

One of the biggest contributors to Deer Park's pollution is a plant owned by Enron, Houston's wealthiest company. Enron is also the single largest contributor (\$555,000 and counting) to the political ambitions of Texas Governor George W. Bush, Republican Candidate for President of the United States. Kenneth Lay, the chief executive of Enron, has personally given over \$100,000 to Bush's political campaigns, more than any other individual. He is also one of the "Pioneers" - a Bush supporter who has collected at least \$100,000 in direct contributions of \$1,000 or less.

Enron is best known as the largest buyer and seller of natural gas in the country. Its 1999 revenues of \$40 billion has made it the 18th largest company in the United States. Enron is invested in energy projects around the world including the UK, Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, the Philippines, Indonesia, China, India and Mozambique.

The company has recently expanded from energy to "bandwidth" capacity for the Internet, making it one of the world's largest Internet-based trading companies, buying and selling a dizzying array of products ranging from pulp and paper to petrochemicals and plastics, as well as esoteric products like clean air credits that utilities purchase to meet emission limits.

Texas activists say that this tight connection between Bush and Lay bodes ill for the country, if Bush is elected. Andrew Wheat, from Texans for Public Justice, a campaign finance advocacy group in Austin, compared the symbiotic relationship between Enron and the

Indeed Bush campaign spokesman Ray Sullivan told Corporate
Watch that, if elected president, the governor is keen to promote the kind of policies that he has crafted with companies like Enron for the state of Texas. "The governor believes in competition, free enterprise, better service and technology improvements. He has promoted sweeping and effective reforms in education and has been the first governor in Texas to seriously address limits on emissions. He will carry his agenda to Washington to do what he believes is best for the country."



But is what Bush believes is good for Texas, good for the United States Of America? Texas has one of the worst environmental records in the country, particularly in the field of air pollution. And its education record is not much better. Unfortunately, the Bush platform for the country is very similar to the kinds of programs that he has worked on with Enron, cutting corporate taxes, deregulating industry and replacing social programs with private sector volunteerism.



In addition Euron is invested in energy projects around the globe-some of which have been tainted by charges of human rights abuses. For example, in India construction of it's controversial Dhabol power plant has brought charges by international groups like Human Rights Watch and Amnesty International of complicity with police brutality in rural communities. It is also accused of human rights violations in Bolivia, where it is building a major gas pipeline threatening indigenous communities and the rainforest environment, according to California-based Amazon Watch.



#### Houston, We Have a Problem

The Enron Methanol plant in Pasadena, Texas lies in the Houston Ship Channel area, the nation's largest concentration of petrochemical plants just east of the city. The Enron Methanol plant has won special concessions from Governor Bush allowing the company to pollute without a permit, as well as giving the company immunity from prosecution for violating the law. Indeed, plants like this in Texas actually emit twice as many nitrogen oxides, a key ingredient of smog, as do all the nine million cars in Texas put together.

"Whole families in this neighborhood have asthma because of the Only seven percent of the more than 3,500 tons of nitrogen oxide emitted by the Enron Methanol plant in 1997 were permitted. Enron got away with this under the "grandfather clause" of the 1971 Texas Clean Air Act which allows plants built before 1971 to continue their polluting practices. Governor Bush extended this clause under the 1999 Clean Air Responsibility Enterprise (CARE) program that his office drew up in a series of secret meetings with representatives of the top polluters in the state. CARE waives permit requirements

The CARE program is backed up by an act that Bush signed in May 1995 giving sweeping protections to polluters who perform internal environmental or safety audits. The law makes these audit documents confidential from the public and allows polluters to escape responsibility for environmental violations. To date Enron has conducted five such audits and filed for immunity from

prosecution for violations of the law, according to the Texas Natural Resources Conservation Commission (TNRCC), the state equivalent of the Environmental Protection Agency.

Tamara Maschini, who lives about five miles from the Enron plant is one of the founders of local environmental group called Clean Air Clear Lake. "Whole families in this neighborhood have asthma because of the pollution from plants like Enron," she says. "It's gotten so bad that NASA has a problem recruiting people to work here at Mission Control which is just down the road. Houston is in trouble and George Bush is the reason-- he has allowed the situation to deteriorate over the past several years," according to Maschini.

Mark Palmer, head of public relations for Enron, says that the company's contribution to local pollution is minimal. "If the grandfather clause was canceled right now, we would benefit the most of any of the companies in Texas because our nitrogen oxide emissions add up to less than half a percent of the total," he told Corporate Watch.

Neil Carman, a former employee of the Texas Air Control Board, who now works for the Sierra Club, agrees that Enron's grandfathered nitrogen emissions add up to less than one percent of the total for all of Texas. However, he points out that Enron Methanol plant alone contributes 3.6% of the nitrogen oxide emissions from the nearly 250 stationary sources of pollution for the city of Houston-the equivalent of 152,500 cars.

What's more, he says that Enron is simply paying lip service to the Bush proposal to cut pollution at grand fathered plants. "Enron showed up at the governor's press conference to volunteer for the CARE program but they have been missing in action ever since. They haven't even bothered to file their voluntary plan."

#### **Enron's Field Of Dreams**

If environmental regulators wanted to speak to Enron's senior officials about the missing voluntary program, they would be well advised to follow the presidential candidate around as he is often chaperoned by Enron officials.

On April 7, 2000, Ken Lay, Enron's chief executive, played host to Bush junior and his father, former president George Bush, at the Houston Astros' first home game of the season at the baseball

team's brand new stadium - Enron Field - which was built with the help of a \$100 million donation from Enron. (The company got free advertising, a tax break and a \$200 million dollar contract to supply power to the stadium in return.)

Less than three weeks later Lay joined Bush in Washington DC for a Republican fund-raiser that topped all previous records by bringing in a staggering \$21.3 million, easily the biggest one-night haul for any political party in history.

That's not all. Lay makes sure that the Bush presidential campaign has access to other Enron facilities. For example last year the Bush campaign borrowed Enron's corporate jets eight times to fly aides around the country, more times than any of the 34 other companies that made their company aircraft available to the presidential

hopeful. (Under federal law, campaigns must reimburse companies for transportation, typically at the cost of a first-class ticket so Enron received \$25,000 from the Bush campaign for this favor).

Lay's ties to Bush junior begin with his father, former President George Bush, whowas also a recipient of Enron/Lay's financial largesse. Like his son now, Bush senior was also happy to return the favor: from 1991 to 1993 Bush appointed Lay to the President's Export Council.

When Corporate Watch asked Ray Sullivan, a spokesman for the Bush campaign, about the relationship between the two men, he chose his words carefully. "Ken Lay is a noted business leader in Texas who has long been active in Republican politics. He is chair of the Governor's Business Council. But the governor has his own agenda based on what he believes is best for Texas and for the country."

Lay toed a similar line when recently interviewed by the New York Times. "When I make contributions to a candidate, it is not for some special favor, it's not even for access — although I'll be the first to admit it probably helps access. It is because I'm supporting candidates I strongly believe in personally." Indeed both Lay and Enron are generous contributors to local and national politicians wherever they do business, often following the long standing corporate practice of funding candidates on both sides of the election.

According to campaign records, Enron and Lay have contributed to Democrats as diverse as Texas Land Commissioner Garry Mauro, U.S. Rep. Richard Gephardt of Missouri and Texas House Speaker Gib Lewis. In 1984, Lay was Harris County chairman of a \$1,000-a-

plate Reagan-Bush fund-raiser, while at the same time co-chairing a fund-raiser for U.S. Sen. Lloyd Bentsen, the vice presidential candidate on the opposing ticket.

Bush delivers just the kind of results that Lay wants. Candidate Bush says he will "work with local jurisdictions using market-based solutions and not try to sue our way or regulate our way to clean air and water." He proposes allowing industries to voluntarily police themselves, just like he did for Enron and the other polluters in Texas.

Texas has regularly ranked as the most environmentally polluted states in this country for years. According to the Environmental Defense Fund, Texas has the worst record of all 50 states in air pollution, water pollution, overall toxic releases, recognized carcinogens in the air, suspected carcinogens in the air, developmental toxins in the air (affecting brain and nervous-system development in children) and cancer risk.

While it is true that Texas was the most polluted state in the country before George W. Bush became governor, the reason it has stayed that way is simple: Bush's policies have effectively allowed these industries to continue to pollute through a system of voluntary compliance.

#### Read His Lips?

Ken Lay and Enron's political beliefs overlap with candidate Bush in other arenas such as education. For example on August 20, 2000 the Houston Astros will host a book drive at Enron Field to promote one of George W Bush and Enron's favorite charities - the Reach Out And Read (ROAR) literacy program.

According to the Environmental Defense Fund, Texas has the worst record of all 50 states in air pollution, water pollution, overall toxic releases and cancer risk.

Launched in 1998, by Laura Welch Bush, the governor's wife, the program calls for physicians and nurse practitioners to give free culturally appropriate books to their pre-school age patients at every checkup. Enron also regularly volunteers its employees to read to children in area clinics and conducts book drives. The cost to Enron for this five year publicity program was \$400,000.

"Along with good nutrition, exercise, care and love, doctors agree that children need a daily dose of parent-child reading. This program will serve as a model for clinics across Texas." said Laura Bush in a press release.

Susan Cooley, the director of Texas ROAR, was gushing in her support for the company, the governor and his wife. "I've been a nurse for 25 years. I don't know anything about sponsorship or advertising. But at Enron they have whole departments to do this, so finding a corporate sponsor has been a godsend," she told Corporate Watch.

However Enron is less than supportive of schools that do not provide similar public relations opportunities. And its political reach goes beyond the governor's mansion. Some 20 miles north of the company's headquarters in Houston Enron has effectively cut approximately \$225,000 from the annual budget of the Spring school district, one of Houston's ethnically diverse, poorer suburbs. Spring, Texas, sits on top of Bammel Field, a huge underground salt cave, which Enron uses to store large quantities of natural gas. As the largest business in

Spring, Enron was required to pay taxes based on the value of its property and mineral holdings on January 1st of each year.

But under a special 1989 provision Enron and other large business property owners were allowed to choose September 1st as their tax assessment date, when the company has less gas stored in Bammel field. Enron was able to reduce its property taxes by \$15 million in 1990, blowing a hole in the school districts budget, Katherine Trumbull, a tax accountant with the school district, told Corporate Watch.

The Spring school district went to court to challenge the new tax provision as unconstitutional and won at the appeals court level. Enron appealed this decision to the Texas Supreme Court. While the case was pending Enron's Political Action Committee (PAC) and senior executives contributed heavily to the election campaigns of every Republican judges vying for seats (all the members of the Texas Supreme Court are elected and may take money from contributors for the campaign expenses). Enron's employees and PAC doled out \$78,700 between the seven of the winning justices in the 1996 campaign including more than \$24,000 from Ken Lay personally. The Supreme Court justices ruled unanimously in Enron's favor on May 6, 1996, a month after Lay gave Chief Justice Thomas Phillips \$5,000 for his campaign.

"I have nothing against Enron, after all they are our biggest taxpayer.

Enron's Palmer had no comment about the tax lawsuit brought by the Spring Independent School District.

### Enron's Global Reach

Enron has also courted Bush's help for its business abroad. For example, in March 1997 Lay wrote a letter to Bush, that was subsequently released to the press under Texas open records laws, asking him to contact every member of the Texas delegation to explain how "export credit agencies of the United States are critical to U.S. developers like Enron, who are pursuing international projects in developing countries."

These agencies include the Overseas Private Investment Corporation (OPIC), a federal agency which provides political risk coverage and financial support to United States companies investing abroad including hundreds of millions of dollars for Enron projects in countries from Brazil to India. Unfortunately for communities in these countries Enron's investments have had devastating impact.

In India where Enron received \$200 million in political risk insurance for the Dabhol offshore oil and gas development project in 1996, the company has been blamed by both Human Rights Watch as well as Amnesty International, for financing local police brutality.

for example, just before dawn on June 3, 1997, police stormed the home of several women in Veldur, a fishing village in western state of Maharashtra, India.

"The policemen forcibly opened the door and dragged me out of the house into the police van parked on the road. (While dragging me) the police kept beating me on my back with batons. The humiliation meted out to the other members of my family was similar to the way I was humiliated... my one and a half year old daughter held on to me but the police kicked her away," says Sugandha Vasudev Bhalekar -- a 24 year old housewife who was three months pregnant at the time of her arrest, according to Amnesty International documentation.

The only "crime" committed by these women was to lead a peaceful protest against a massive new Enron natural gas plant. An investigative team from Amnesty International found that a number of the women subsequently sustained injuries, including bruising, abrasions and lacerations on arms and legs. Several hundred other peaceful protestors have been arrested and temporarily detained by Indian police since December 1996, according to the report. Meanwhile, a January 1999 investigation by Human Rights revealed that the police were directly on the Enron payroll. (see India sidebar)

Likewise, Enron has been severely criticized for the Cuiabá Integrated Energy Project in Bolivia and Brazil, for which it received US\$200 million in insurance from OPIC in 1999.

On February 4, 2000 an oil pipeline operated by Transredes, a joint venture between Enron and Shell in the Cuiabá Integrated Energy Project, erupted in the Bolivian altiplano and dumped an estimated 10,000 barrels of refined crude oil and gasoline into the Desaguadero River, which supports indigenous communities like the Uru Moratos. Facing starvation from the loss of their life- sustaining waterfowl and fish, the Uru Moratos left their ancestral lands at the southern shores of Lake Poopo in April and marched 85 miles to the city of Oruro to ask for government help.

#### White House Hopes

in January 1999 Enron pitched in \$50,000 to help pay for Bush's inaugural bash in Austin, Texas, when he won the reelection for governor. Today the polls show that George W. Bush currently has a better than even chance of winning the November presidential elections and moving from Austin to Washington DC.

If he does, it is very likely Ken Lay will be on hand when Bush is inaugurated as the next president of the United States, hoping that in return for generously supporting his campaign, Bush will be equally generous in his support for Enron's businesses at home and abroad in the future.

environmentally friendly business decisions, purchases all of it's electricity from Enron Wind. The first company in California to do so. (The Energy Report, July 13, 1998)



Enrolls pipeline project with Florida Gas Transmission Co, was found in violation 109 times regarding wetlands destruction and improper land clearing and damaging waterways in 1994. It paid \$575,400 in fines. (Oregonian, August 6, 1996 and Southeast Energy Power Report, December 16, 1994)



Enron and Dutch Shell's pipeline in Bolivia ruptured on January, 2000, and spilled 29,000 barrels of crude petroleum. This contaminated "hundreds of acres of organic farmland, killing fish and birds in the Andes' lake Poopo, and destroying the livelihood of a 5,000 year old native tribe, Uru Morato". Enron and it's Bolivian partner, Transredes has spent \$ 10-mil so far on the oil spill, and clean-up has not yet been completed, a spokesman for Enron Corp, which owns 50% of Transredes, said late Mar 21. (Friends of the Poopo and the Uru Morato, Vermont, USA and Platt's Oilgram News, March 23, 2000)



Enron, Shell and Transredes are building a 390 mile pipeline in Bolivia that has "brought serious environmental and social problems" to local communities living along its path. They have so far experienced, "pollution of local water resources, degradation of local roads, soil and air pollution...". (A World Class Disaster: The Case of the Bolivia-Cuiaba Pipeline, A Report on the Failures of Enron international to Comply with Bolivian Environmental Laws and OPIC Loan Conditions in the Construction of the Lateral Ipias-Cuiaba Gas Pipeline, December 8, 1999) Activist have been pressuring the US Overseas Private Investment Corporation to pull it's support of the Cuiaba Pipeline Project, however, Enron has stated that it will proceed with the project, whether or not it gets OPIC funding. (Financial Times (London) July 15, 1999)

# International Violations

Enron's activities with their Dabhol Power project in India has been documented by Human Rights Watch as violating the human rights of locals protesting the project, the largest power plant in the world. "The Dabhol Power Corporation and it's parent company, Enron, are complicit in these human rights violations. Enron's local entity, the Dabhol power Corp. benefited directly from an official policy of suppressing dissent through misuse of the law, harassment of anti-Enron protest leaders and prominent environmental activists, and police practices ranging from arbitrary to brutal". (The Enron Corporation: Corporate Complicity in Human Rights Violations, Jan 1999, Human Rights Watch)

Enron's water division, Azurix Corp, is the city water supply company for the community of Bahia Blanca in Buenos Aires. In April, 2000, the water supply was laced with toxic bacteria that cause skin irritation and possible neurological damage. (Reuters, April 25, 2000)

The World Bank is objecting to the terms of a power purchase agreement between Enron and the state of Lagos (Nigeria) in December of 1999. The terms are too

favorable to Enron: they acquired a long-term right to sell power to Lagos without competitive bidding; can charge a high price for the fuel used by its power plant; cannot be penalized for the poor performance of its plants; does not fully bear the completion risks for the plants under its control; benefits from generous arrangements for payment security; and would receive excessive contract termination payments. (EIU ViewsWire, May 25, 2000)






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

From Vickie: How to Prepare for the Move to BMC

Hi,

Well it won't be long and you will be working out of the BMC building. To ensure a smooth transition, please take a minute to review the packing instructions below.

First, be aware that each person will be responsible for boxing up and moving their own breakables and valuables into their new office.

Then, all furniture, bookcases and file cabinets need to be unloaded of all their contents and packed in boxes for the movers to pick up and move for you along with your furniture. Come see me for boxes, labels, masking tape and packing tape.

Be sure to unload all furniture (desk, hutch or credenza) of all files and tape shut all the drawers with masking tape (which is more easily removed than packing tape). Do the same for all file cabinets and tape shut these drawers with masking tape. Unload all bookcases and put the contents into boxes also. Be sure to put labels on your boxes with this information printed on each (last name, phone #, current office #, new office # and what # this box is of the total boxes be moved... 2 of 5). Consider using a yellow highlighter to make your new office # more outstanding on all of the boxes.

Put a label on your office trash can with this information printed on it (last name, phone #, current office # and new office #) and then place your keyboard, mouse, speakers and phone in the trash can. Don't worry about your computer as it will be moved for you.

Using masking tape, print your last name and new office # on it, and then place on the top or front portion of each piece of furniture where it can be easily seen. If your chair or chairs are made of cloth put a label on each seat with the same information as on your trash can. Then protect the label with a piece of packing tape. However, if you have a leather chair or chairs then use a strip of masking tape with your last name and new office # on it.





My name is Jean Bennett, I live at 3051 Palm Aire Drive, Pompano Beach.

Enron representatives have mentioned that there will be approximately 10 employees at their anticipated manufacturing plant after it is constructed. Considering the size of this property that will be a minimal amount of automobile traffic daily. And Enron feels that this is a plus for Pompano.

HOWEVER, they do not publicize the fact that during their peak times of operation, there will be a daily caravan of approximately 70 fuel tankards travelling down our major and local highways emitting diesel fuel. They will unload their contents at the Sample Avenue site. This site will house 1,000,000 gallons of fuel!

Besides the emission from these trucks, the caravan will represent a catastrophe waiting to happen. I am sure you all remember the accident that occurred a few years ago at Cypress Creek and Dixie Highway. A train and fuel tank collided. It sounded like a bomb and it looked like the cloud formation of the atomic mushroom. Fortunately, no one on the train was hurt - they were in the dining car at the rear. I am against the plant being constructed in Broward County and hope you will not grant the permit.



At the Public meeting on March 26, 2001, we were asked to direct our comments only to the Air quality and the proposed Air Construction Permit to be issued to Pompano Beach Energy L.L.C. for the purpose of constructing three 170-Megawatt natural gas and distillate fuel oil-fired combustion turbine generators by the Enron Corporation.

It is impossible to think that fragmenting the components that produce either a desirable or a undesirable, unhealthy environment could even be considered in the construction of these power plants. The construction of these plants will degrade air quality further than what can be measured. The trucks required to transport the diesel fuel to run these plants will add to the degradation. The construction of 80 foot smoke stacks that will also disperse additional contaminants into the air. We have not yet touched on the chemicals that would be required to operate the inlet chillers, the inevitable spills of diesel fuel from the storage tanks, and the elimination of the fluids required to operate the wet mechanical draft cooling towers. All these will have a negative impact on the environment and public health and welfare. They will only serve to contaminate the remainder of the environment.



Apparently, the construction of these, power plants were precluded from being built in or near the Everglades due to the delicate balance of the environment and its affect on endangered species. Doesn't this raise a question in any-ones mind as to its affect on the surrounding population, especially the young and elderly who already suffer from Asthma and Emphysema. Are we all so self-serving that we have not also considered the inevitable damage these Power Plants will cause to our fragile environment? Does any-one care? We are only within a few miles of the Everglade conservation area.

The proposed power plants are presently not required to maintain energy levels in south Florida. Presently, Florida Power and light is producing a, twenty percent, excess in energy. Their engineers estimate that they will have more than a sufficient amount of power over the next decade. There must be a balance between the need for new electrical power plants and the need to provide reliable service. Please, lets determine the need. The proposed Enron Power Plants will not be required to sell its energy to local customers. It will not be answerable to the Public Service Commission in any fashion. If in fact Enron is going to produce energy, at required peak periods, it won't be required here. They should be built in areas that are in need of additional power plants and are not heavily or densely populated; preferably out of southern Florida and further in another state with a greater requirement.

Local considerations should also be given to the existing tourist trade and the revenues presently generated form attractions like Butterfly world and the draw of thousands of shoppers in the merchant shops at Festival Flea Market. Pompano Beach should consider the tax base and the retail opportunity that exist should the Power Plant site be developed as an industrial business center or other corporate or individual sites. The existing small business commercial residents may be driven from our area creating a significant drop in our tax base.

We in the cities of Pompano Beach, Deerfield Beach, Parkland, Coral Springs, Margate, Coconut Creek, North Lauderdale, are presently surrounded with and embraced with the unpleasant sites of a water treatment plant, a hazardous waste disposal area, a garbage land fill, and sewage treatment plants. These sites already have a negative impact on the quality of the air we as residents breathe in every day. If you are in doubt, on any given day, visit the areas near Powerline Road or the Florida Turnpike near sample road and take a deep breath of the air that is supposedly safe to breath. We don't need these Enron Power Plants nor do we want them in this area. Please do not allow this to happen. Stop it before its too late and we find it's a mistake.

Dear Mr. Linero:

Thank you for your presentation last night regarding the proposed Enron Pompano Beach project. As you could tell from the tone of the meeting, the residents and officials of the area are opposed to the Department of Environmental Protection granting an air permit to Enron.

Mr. Linero, many people expressed valid fears last night. I understand that you only have jurisdiction over the air permit, so I'll leave my commentary about the proposed locations of these power plants out of this correspondence. I concur with the fears expressed by the officials and residents last night. The proposed sites are just too close to residential areas to allow the air permit.

Power plants generate tons of nitrogen oxides, particulate matter, and sulfur dioxide. My wife and I are young, and about to start a family. We do not want any of our children exposed for years to these emissions. I assume that you are an engineer of some sort. As you know, science is constantly evolving. The decision you make today could be proven substantially flawed in the future. When you make your decision on whether or not to grant the permit, please consider this. In fact, put yourself in my shoes. Would you want a powerplant constructed fifty feet from your property line? I would venture to say your answer, based solely upon the proposed emissions, would be an absolute NO.

Mr. Linero, I am a veteran of the commercial printing industry. I have worked for several printing companies throughout the state requiring DEP issued air permits for their heatset web-offset printing presses. Emission controls such as afterburners are machines that require repair and maintenance. I have personally witnessed multiple violations of these permits when management made the decision to run their presses when the pollution control equipment was inoperable. During all of these multiple violations, numbering at least a hundred, I saw an EPA official exactly once. So industries requiring air permits largely police themselves, and in my experience, often defy the restraints of their permit to run their equipment. Again, I ask you--if this proposal was for a power plant adjacent to your neighborhood, would you approve the air permit? I am certain you would say NO.

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection exists to prevent residents from being exposed to pollution. As an engineer, you work with figures based upon fuels and burn rates and histories of other power plants. But in a real world setting, you do not know exactly what will happen. What would the emissions be if the power plant gets a contaminated load of fuel? What happens if, after the construction, Enron wants to run their machines all the time? What happens if the natural gas pipeline is ruptured? Many residents made a valid point about the motor traffic required to fill the diesel fuel tanks. Hundreds of tanker trucks rolling through a largely residential area create many more tons of emissions. Are these emissions being considered in the air permit?

I apologize for the unruliness of the crowd last night. I'm sure you can tell this proposal has many residents nervous. Enron is a powerful company who has found a loophole in the Power Plant Locator Act of 1973 to find a way to construct these facilities. We fear for our health, our families' health and our property values. If Enron wants to build a power plant in Florida, perhaps they can find a more reasonable location. I travel throughout the state, and I see many uninhabited rural areas that stand to gain much more than the proposed sites. Certainly a more rural area will expose less Floridians to pollution. Additionally, an area well north of here would pose no threat to the Everglades.

Mr. Linero, I am counting on you to protect my environmental rights. You have a job to protect me, my family, and all of the residents opposed to this plan. Please do this by denying the air permit. I am certain that you know this is the only right decision. If you have any doubts, put yourself in our shoes. If it were being built in YOUR backyard, would you want it?

Dear Mr. Linero:

I am deeply concerned about the possibility that your department may grant an Air Construction Permit to Pompano Beach Energy L.L.C. so they can build their electrical plant in Pompano Beach. The first problem as we know is that the air quality studies do not include all the possible amounts of Sulfur Dioxide that may be released into the air from the diesel fuel that will be used. I am also concerned about the amounts of nitrogen oxide that will be released into the air. I suffer from asthma and I do not want or need anything else in this area that can pollute the air that I breathe and cause me more health problems. I am concerned about the possible land and water pollution that may occur throughout the entire area as toxic pollutants seep into the ground and contaminate our water. I must remind you that there are areas of the Everglades that are within several miles of these proposed power plants. The general wind direction in our area may carry toxins directly into the everglades causing widespread environmental damage. Additionally, my wife and I are concerned that the decrease in air quality will affect the health of our son who is only 5 years old. I would like him to grow up in an area with the cleanest environment possible. I am concerned about the health risk to my family, friends and neighbors if this power plant is allowed to pollute our air. Many residents will be affected in this densely populated residential area if the proposed sites are built.

Mr. Linero, as you know this issue goes much deeper than the affects of just one power plant. We must protect ourselves from the fact that your department and our neighboring cities may grant approval to two other power plants in very close proximity located in neighboring Deerfield Beach.
