**ORDER WITHDRAWING NOVEMBER 18, 2009, ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR HEARING AND
ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

This cause came before the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Department) on receipt of a request for extension of time to file a petition for administrative proceeding (Request) made by Florida Power Corporation (Petitioner) on a draft Title V renewal permit, DEP permit number 0170004-024-AV, issued to Petitioner for its Crystal River Power Plant, located in Citrus County, Florida.

On November 18, 2009, the Department issued an order denying Petitioner's Request as being untimely filed. The Department has reconsidered its timeliness determination and because the Request shows good cause for the extension of time,


IT IS ORDERED:

- A. The Department's November 18, 2009, Order Denying Request for Extension of Time to File Petition for Administrative Hearing with Leave to Amend is **WITHDRAWN**.
- B. Petitioner's Request is **GRANTED**. Petitioner shall have through **December 9, 2009**, to file a petition for administrative hearing in this matter. Filing shall be complete upon

receipt by the Office of General Counsel, Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000.
