The Department of Environmental Protection (permitting authority) gives notice of its intent to issue a Title V air operation permit to Florida Power Comparation for the Crystal River Plant located at Power Line Road, West of U.S. Hwy. 19, Crystal River, FL 34428, Citrus County. The applicant's name and address is Mr. W. Jeffrey Paratue, C.E.P. Director, Environmental Services Department, 3201 34th Street South, St. Petersburg, FL 33711.

The permitting authority will issue Title V PROPOSED Permit, and subsequent Title V FINAL Permit, in accordance with the conditions of the Title V DRAFT Permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The permitting authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed Title V DRAFT Permit issuance action for a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Stotion # 5505, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400. Any written comments received result in a significant change in this DRAFT Permit, the permitting authority shall issue a Revised a iDRAFT Permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice. The permitting authority will issue the permit with attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Section 120.559 and 120.57, Florida Statutes (F.S.). Mediation under Section 120.573, F.S., will not be available for this proposed action.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the province of the process of the proces

is filed pursuant to Section 120.59' and 120.57. Florida Statutes (F.S.). Medication under Section 120.573. F.S., will not be available for this proposed action.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57. F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Coursel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station, 35, Tatlahassee, Florida 32999-3000 (releiphone) 590/488-9730. Fax: 850/487-4938). Petitions must be filed within 14 (fourteen) days of publication of the public notice or within 14 (fourteen) days of receipt of the notice of intent, whichever occurs first. A petitioner must mail a copy of the petition to the applicant of the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the applicable time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-5.207 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition must contain the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Permit File Number, and the county in which the project is proposed;

(b) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial Interests are affected by the permitting authority's action or proposed action:

(c) A statement of the material facts disputed by the petition of the proposed;

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final action for the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance, with the requirements set forth above. In addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Coder (U.S.C.)
