This letter shall serve as notification that Pro-Line Boats, as a manufacturer of fiberglass boats, may be subject to 40 CFR 63, Subpart WWWW, re: Boat Manufacturing, with an applicability date of August 22, 2004. We are not certain, however, and would appreciate a determination of applicability from the Department.

Pro-Line Boats (Facility ID # 0170029) is located at 1520 South Suncoast Boulevard, Homosassa, Citrus County, Florida 34448 and is owned by American Marine Holdings, 7110 - 21st Street East; Sarasota, Florida 34243.

Boats manufactured at this facility are produced using an open-molding process, employing manual and mechanical application of resin and mechanical application of gelcoat.

Mechanical application of resin is effected through the use of 'Flow-Coater' non-atomized "chopper" guns and the gelcoat is applied with "FIT" (Fluid Impingement Technology) guns.

Emissions points consist of ten 48" Wall Exhaust Fans with a flow rate of 18,120 acfm each. The fans are located on the East, North and West walls of the Lamination building (see diagram), and are hooded at the exterior of the building.
