Dear Ms. Vielhauer:

Thank you for the opportunity to review the proposed Best Available Retrofit Technology (BART) technology evaluation for the Turkey Point Fossil Power Plant on February 28, 2008. We have reviewed the draft and have the following comment below:

<u>Timeframe for Installing Proposed BART Controls:</u> On page 5-3 in Section 5.1, FPL indicates that "These changes are proposed to be effective 5 years after EPA approves the state implementation plan (SIP) revision that FDEP must submit as part of the BART regulations. The date that this strategy would be implemented by FPL is anticipated to be in 2013 or 2014." As specified in 40 CFR 51.308(e)(1)(v), States are required to ensure that each source subject to BART install and operate BART as expeditiously as practicable, but in no event later than 5 years after approval of the implementation plan revision. FPL's BART Determination should be revised to explain why the controls will not be in place before 2013 or 2014. Every effort should be made to install the controls "as expeditiously as practicable."


