Dear Mr. Koerner:

On behalf of CEMEX I am sending you this letter to request approval to install 8" portholes in the base of the precalciner at the CEMEX Construction Materials Florida LLC, Miami Cement Plant. The portholes are requested to be installed now in anticipation for future trial testing of alternative materials/fuels. The request is made to install during the next kiln outage coming up in May of 2010 because the kiln must be down for the ports to be installed. If the ports are not installed during this time frame, the kiln is not expected to come down for a scheduled outage until, at the earliest, fall season of 2010. CEMEX fully understands that these portholes shall not be used until permit authorization is final from the Department.
