Here are some my comments with regards to the Draft Title V Air Construction Permit 0250281-006-AC, PSD-FL-248 and related technical documents for the Preston WTP:

Regarding the Technical Evaluation (TE) and Preliminary Determination:

1. The word "maximum" should be inserted before "0.05%" in the last paragraph in Section 6. "Air Pollution Control Techniques", which states "...very low sulfur diesel fuel (0.05% sulfur by weight)" for consistency within the TE and with the application. This may eliminate the SED issuing a compliance requirement of "below 0.05%.." instead of say.. "..not to exceed 0.05% sulfur by weight..".

Regarding the Draft Air Construction Permit 0250281-006-AC, PSD-FL-248:

- 1. Include the word "Standby" before "Generator" in all of the emissions unit descriptions found in Section I, "Facility Information" and Section III, "Emissions Unit Specific Conditions". This is minor issue at this plant, as there are no other emergency generators or primary generators as there are at other MDWASD plants.
- 2. The note at the end of Section III, Operational Requirement, condition 2 is acceptable as stated, as long as it is not construed as an additional operational limitation in the Title V operating permit issued by FDEP SED.
- 3. The note at the end of Section III, condition 5 is acceptable as stated, as long as it is not construed as an additional emission limitation in the Title V operating permit issued by FDEP SED.
- 4. Revise the last sentence of condition 7 to state, "The owner or operator may comply with this requirement by receiving records from the fuel supplier that indicate the sulfur content of the fuel delivered, complies with the sulfur limit of specific condition 2 of this section." Indicate, show, or demonstrate..



The comments and revised RO pages for Preston arrived today at last! Regarding the comments:

- 1. I will change the RO.
- 2. I agree that the hourly heat input rates and fuel consumption rates should not be made a limitation in the Title V permit. Be sure to review the draft Title V permit from the district office regarding this.
- 3. Specific condition 7 in Section III does allow for WASD to comply with the fuel sulfur records by receiving certification by the fuel supplier, provided the supplier utilizes the ASTM test methods. I see that the condition as written implies that each delivery must be tested, although that was not necessarily the intent if the fuel supplier certifies the sulfur content. I will consider rephrasing this condition so that the supplier may certify the sulfur content of each delivery, without being required to test each load. Do your purchase records specify the sulfur content? Do they mention any test methods?

Dear Mr. Linero:

The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (MDWASD) has received a copy of the above referenced draft construction permit and technical evaluation issued by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). Our comments on the draft permit are as follows:

- 1. The responsible official for the John E. Preston WTP has changed. Four signed revised permit application sheets are attached.
- 2. The heat input rates of the diesel engines are acceptable as stated in Section III, Operational Requirement 2. However, the hourly heat input (and fuel consumption) rates noted should not be included as an operational limitation in the Title V operating permit issued by FDEP Southeast District.
- 3. The fuel sulfur content testing and testing recording requirement found in requirements 7 and 8 create an extreme burden to MDWASD and suppliers. Currently, MDWASD is complying with the fuel maximum sulfur content limitation by purchasing lo-sulfur grade diesel. Requirement 7 should be modified to allow the facility to demonstrate compliance with the maximum sulfur content limitation by maintaining records on the type of fuel delivered as indicated on the shipping manifests by the supplier or suppliers transporter. This method of certification by the supplier is preferred as the testing of each individual tank truck delivery, and references to the testing methods on the shipping manifests presents an undue burden on MDWASD and suppliers.



The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) gives notice of its intent to issue an air construction permit to Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department, for the John E. Preston WTP located at 110 West 2nd Avenue, Hialeah, Miami-Dade County. The permit is to allow the application to increase operation of six existing diesel engine generators to provide power generation capacity during periods of load-sharing with the local utility, during power failures and other circumstances including severe weather warnings and events of potential electric utility power losses or reductions. The applicant's mailing address is: 4200 Salzedo, Street, Coral Gables, Florida 33146-0316. A Best Available Control Technology (BACT) determination was required for nitrogen oxides (NOx) pursuant to Rule 62-212.400, F.A.C. and 40 CFR 52.21, Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD). Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) emissions will be controlled by the use of fuel injection timing retardation and turbocharger aftercooling.

Total emissions of pollutants shall not exceed the following annual emission rates in tons per year: NOx, 370; PMPM₁₀, 5.1 Sulfur dioxide, 4.6; VOC, 7.2; CO, 28.4.

An air quality impact analysis was conducted. Emissions from the facility will not cause or contribute to a violation of any state or federal ambient air quality standards. The maximum predicted PSD NO₂ increment consumed by all sources, including this project, in the nearest Class I (Everglades National Park) and Class II areas will be as follows:

The Department will issue the Final permit with the attached conditions unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions:

The Department will accept written comments and requests for public meetings concerning the proposed permit issuance action for a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of publication of this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit. Written comments and requests for public meetings should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, FL 32399-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in the proposed agency action, the Department shall revise the proposed permit and require, if applicable another Public Notice.

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filled pursuant to sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. before the deadline for filling a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

Mediation is not available in this proceeding

TRING STEER TERRETERS THE SECTION OF

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under sections 120,569 and 120,57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000. Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under section 120.60(3), however, any person who asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within tourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filling. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106 205 of the Florida Administrative Code

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, it known; (b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner, the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of how and when petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate; (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.
