Dear Mr. Hawkins:

On August 16, 2010, we received your application and sufficient fee for an air construction permit to construct and operate a landfill gas-to-energy facility at Medley Landfill, which will use landfill gas as fuel for six Caterpillar (CAT 3520) engines. The facility is located in Miami-Dade County at 9350 Northwest 89th Avenue in Medley, Florida. The application was deemed incomplete and we requested additional information needed to process your application on December 15, 2010. On December 21st, we held a teleconference and discussed the requested information. We received your modeling report on December 30, 2010 and modeling files on January 5, 2011. We have still not received a response to question 1 – 5 from our December 15th request. Rule 62-4.055(1) of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) requires the following:

"The applicant shall have **ninety days** after the Department mails a timely request for additional information to submit that information to the Department. If an applicant requires more than ninety days in which to respond to a request for additional information, the applicant may notify the Department in writing of the circumstances, at which time the application shall be held in active status for one additional period of up to ninety days. Additional extensions shall be granted for good cause shown by the applicant. A showing that the applicant is making a diligent effort to obtain the requested additional information shall constitute good cause. Failure of an applicant to provide the timely requested information by the applicable deadline shall result in denial of the application."

It has been more than 40 days since our request for additional information (copy attached). You are reminded that the permit processing time clock has stopped for this project and that we will not continue our review until we receive the additional information. If you require a period of time in addition to the 90 days allowed by rule, please submit a written request indicating the amount of time necessary. If you fail to provide the additional information or request additional time to submit the additional information, we will deny your application for air permit. Dear Mr. Hawkins:

On November 22, 2010, we received your response from our request for addition information regarding the construction and operation of a landfill gas-to-energy facility at Medley Landfill, which will use landfill gas as fuel for six Caterpillar (CAT 3520) engines. The facility is located in Miami-Dade County at 9350 Northwest 89th Avenue in Medley, Florida. The application indicates that the project is subject to preconstruction review for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) of Air Quality pursuant to Rule 62-212.400, of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The application is incomplete. In order to continue processing your application, please provide the additional information requested below. Should your response to any of the requested items require new calculations, please submit the new calculations, assumptions, reference material and appropriate revised pages of the application form.

- 1. The Medley facility is an open municipal solid waste (Class I) landfill. Does the facility also include any Class III or construction and demolition landfills? Based on your current solid waste permits, please identify the landfill capacity in the following terms: acres, million megagrams (mass) and million cubic meters (volume). Please include waste in place as well as future capacity that is permitted under a solid waste permit. Based on the current design capacity specified in the solid waste permits, estimate the potential annual NMOC emissions (megagrams per year).
- 2. The revised Table 2-2 (Potential Emissions from Existing 6,000 SCFM Enclosed Flare (EU ID 005)) was not included in your attachments. Please submit.
- 3. Rule 62-210.370, F.A.C. establishes a hierarchy for emissions calculations (e.g., continuous emission monitoring system (CEMS), mass balance, stack test data and emission factors). The objective is to use the available data that best represents emissions from the project. The Department agrees that the project is subject to PSD preconstruction review or CO, NO_X and PM₁₀ emissions increases. However, since the application projects SO₂ emissions increases just below the PSD significant emissions rate, please use the specific H₂S emissions data available for the Medley landfill to determine baseline actual SO₂ emissions. For the projected actual emissions, also use H₂S data specific to the Medley landfill and provide additional information to support any claim that the H₂S concentration in landfill gas will increase or decrease in the future. The referenced letter (dated November 21, 2008 from the Department of Environmental Resources

Management) does not supersede the requirements of Rule 62-210.370, F.A.C. Also, please explain how the 2008 PSD applicability issue addressed in this letter was resolved.

- 4. Your response states that the project is not subject to PSD review for SO₂ emissions because the SO₂ emissions increase will be "limited" to no more than 39 tons per year, which is less than the PSD significant emissions rate. This is based on an estimated maximum H₂S concentration in landfill gas of 830 ppmv. Please explain how the H₂S concentration will be maintained below a maximum level of 830 ppmv.
- 5. Please estimate the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions increases resulting from this project. Based on current federal regulations, it will be necessary to obtain a separate PSD permit that specifies the Best Available Control Technology for reducing GHG emissions if GHG emissions increases are greater than 75,000 tons per year.
- 6. Please provide the additional information requested regarding the air quality analysis.

The above information is requested pursuant to the following F.A.C. regulations: Rule 62-4.050 (Procedures to Obtain Permits and Other Authorizations; Applications); 62-4.055 (Permit Processing); 62-4.070 (Standards for Issuing or Denying Permits; Issuance; Denial); 62-4.120 (Construction Permits); 62-204.800 (Federal Regulations Adopted by Reference); 62-212.300 (Permits Required); 62-210.370 (Emissions Computations and Reporting); 62-210.900 (Forms and Instructions); 62-212.300 (General Preconstruction Review); and 62-212.400 (Prevention of Significant Deterioration). All applications for a Department permit must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida pursuant to Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C. This requirement also applies to responses to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. For any material changes to the application, please include a new certification statement by the authorized representative or responsible official.

We will resume processing your application after receipt of the requested information. You are reminded that Rule 62-4.055(1), F.A.C. requires applicants to respond to requests for information within 90 days or to provide a written request for an additional period of time to submit the information.
