The Bio-Environmental Services Division (BESD) has received and reviewed the above referenced permits. BESD does not have any comments to be considered for the Department's proposed action.

BESD does have concerns on an item related to this project. The Department's correspondence dated January 19, 1990 - Modification of Construction Permits AC16-119130 and AC16-119132, established an expiration date of October 30, 1991 for both permits. Operation permits have been issued for both sources. BESD has concerns for the validity of the operation permits (AO16-140099 [Four Boilers] and AO16-147102 [Duct Burner]) with the extended expiration date of the construction permits.

Please advise BESD as to which permits (operation or construction) are applicable for determining compliance during this period in regard to emission limits, test frequency, and other compliance-related issues.
